


REVELATION 26 – SARDIS: LIVING WITNESS TO LOST



CHRIST – KNOWS YOUR WORKS

- Worship is a continual state:<u>Your</u> decisions reveal <u>your</u> truth; <u>your</u> worship (ISa 16:7)
- Wide Path: Bordered by Fallen Reason {Illogic} & <u>Self</u>-Experience {Emotion-Driven}
 - Satan's Tent {Self-righteous Works}: Enforced unity {Lie of Diversity} (1Sa 15:23; Jn 8:4-47)
- Narrow Path: Bordered by Wisdom {Bibleguided Knowing} and Faith {Gift of Spirit}
 - Christ's Tent {Faith Works}: Works reveal Christ in Us {New Nature} {True Diversity} (Ga 2:20; Col 1:27; Ja 2:17-26)



OLD TESTAMENT: FEAR – BEGINNING OF WISDOM NEW TESTAMENT: FRIENDS – ADOPTED SONS



There is no fear in love, but *mature* love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and Whoever fears has not been *completed* in love. (ICo 13:12; He 10:29-31; IJo 4:18)

SARDIS: FEW WHO ARE ALIVE – I) CLOTHED IN RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Garment: metaphor of one's flesh, with its associated works, carried over from Old Testament: Sinners described being <u>clothed</u> in disgusting rags: Menstrual blood & Fecal-urine stained (Is 64:6-8; ICo 15:42-50; Jude 22-23)
 - Saved described being clothed in the garments of salvation {Christ's Righteousness} (Is 61:10-11; Ga 3:27-29; Ph 3:8-11)
- Christ shows Himself Head of church elder, steward, who if they remain faithful display their salvation works, clothed in Christ, like High Priest Joshua whose sin-{fecal} stained robes were exchanged for righteous {clean} ones (Ze 3:1-8)
 - Sardis' faithful few refused to soil themselves <u>again</u> in sin's filth; unlike today's believers (2Pe 2:20-22)
 - Their testimony can cost them dearly in the World: Revelation Theme (Mt 5:10-12; Re 7:9-17)

SARDIS: FEW WHO ARE ALIVE – 2) NAME WRITTEN IN *BOOK OF LIFE*

- Another Old Testament metaphor: Book of Life {Immutably permanent} (Ex 32:32-33)
 - Contains names of all whom Christ saves; written before Creation (Lk 10:20; Ep 1:3-14; Ph 4:3)
 - Christ, Lamb, intimately linked with this Book; written in His Blood (IPe 1:18-22-25; Re 13:8)
 - You cannot remove or add your name: New Name Title Describing Your Faith* (Mt 7:21-23; Jn 10:25-30; Re 2:17; 20:11-15)
- You do not persevere against Death-Satan-World-Flesh alone (Ep 6:12-13)
 - We stand; Christ-Spirit-Word fight for us: we required to be faithful (ICo 4:1-2; Ep 6:14-20)
 - Perseverance taxes us to our limits displaying Christ in the World (Mt 10:34-39; Lk 12:11-12)
 - Our identity: Crucified in Christ; <u>our</u> trials are His *maturing* us {Hagiazo Process} (Ro 8:26-30; Ga 2:20; He 5:11-14)

SARDIS: FEW WHO ARE ALIVE – 3) CHRIST CONFESSES US **ALWAYS**

- In our weakness we may be ashamed of Christ, but He never is ashamed to confess {identity with} us as His own (Mt 26:30-35; Ro 1:16; Ph 1:19-21)
 - If we never confess Christ to Lost, He <u>cannot</u> confess us to Father (Mk 8:37-38)
 - Christ confesses, identifies with, Saved to Father and Angels so all know who is saved; may safely pass the gaze of the Seraphim: Guardians of His holiness {Mercy Seat} (Ex 25:17-22; Mt 10:32-33; Lk 12:8-9; He 2:5-18; 9:1-5)
- Church of Sardis <u>not</u> ashamed to follow the World; except for the faithful few
 - Everyone encounters this fork in the road; in their strength: Failure Sin
 - Believers, in Christ's-Spirit's strength: Success, at great cost now but not compared to eternity in New Jerusalem – Can You hear the Spirit Speaking? (He 11:32-40; 13:9-14)
