Main Point:

Despite any obstacles you may face, be persistent in faith-fueled prayer, humbly anticipating your requests to be granted eventually.

1. You will often face obstacles in life that will tempt you not to pray.

2. Despite the obstacles, the Lord wants you to be persistent in prayer.

3. To be persistent, your prayers must be fueled by faith in Jesus.
