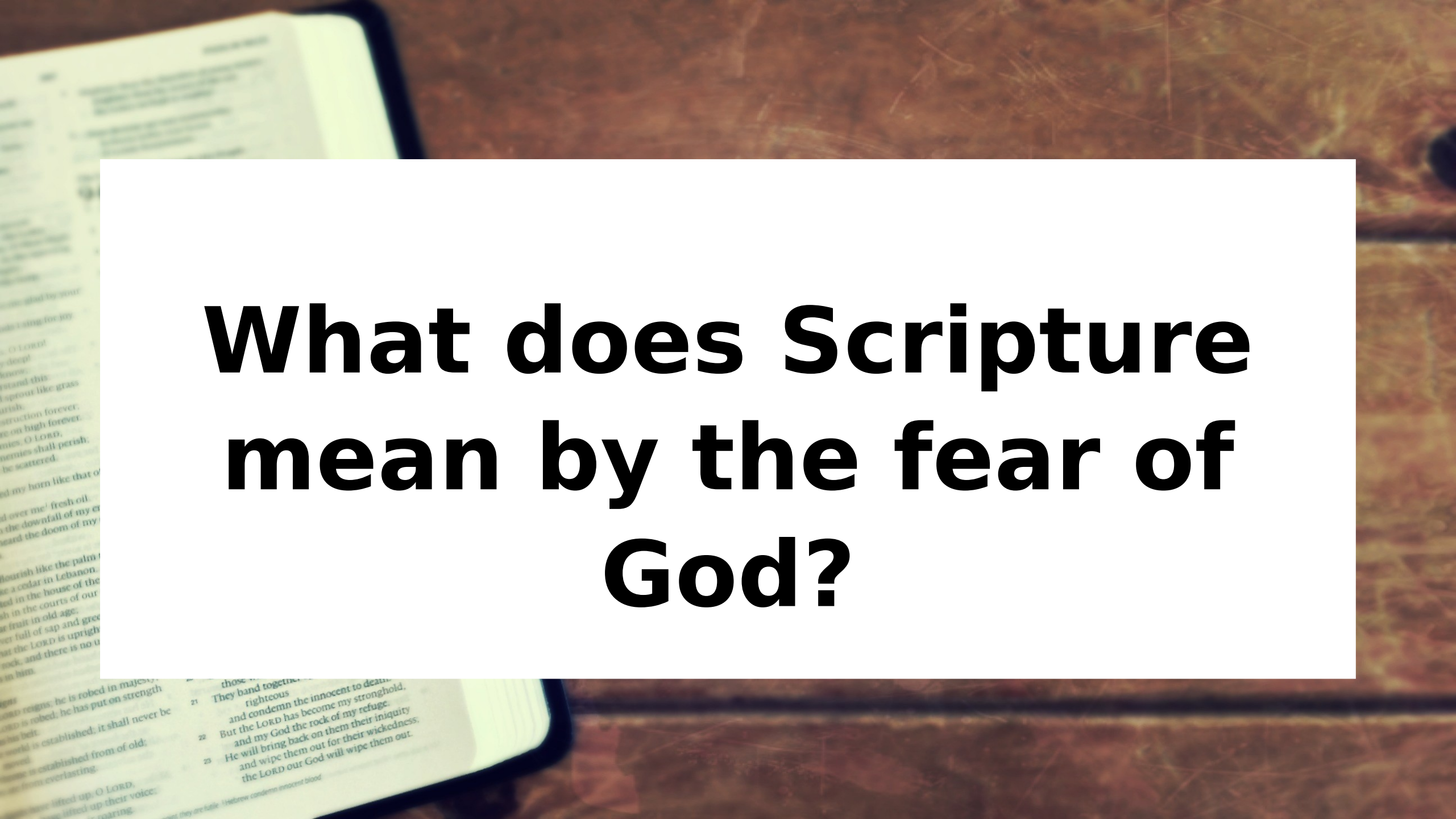

## It means two things.

⇒ To fear God means to hold Him in fear, dread, and terror.

⇒ To fear God means to hold Him in awe, to reverence the holiness, power, knowledge, wisdom, judgment and wrath of God.

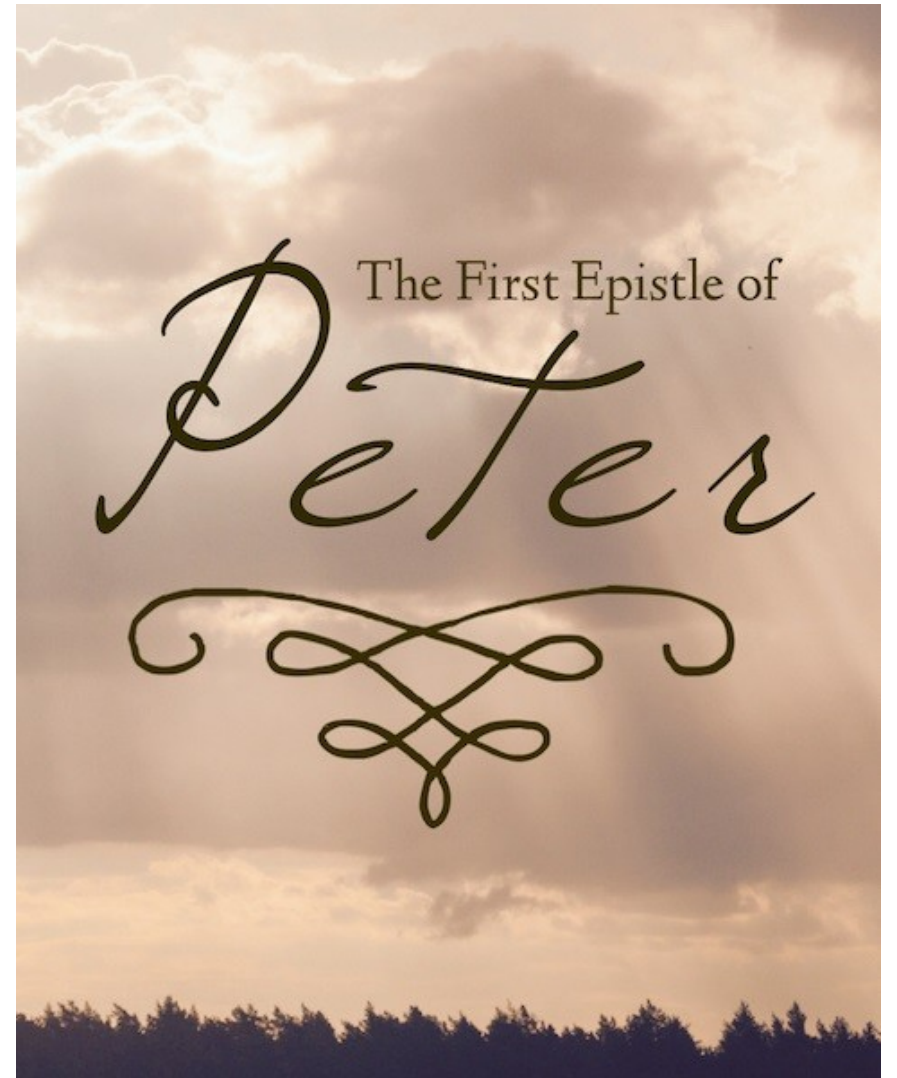



Note that the word "**fear**" ( phobō PWS: 1454 ) is used.

It means to hold God in reverence and awe.

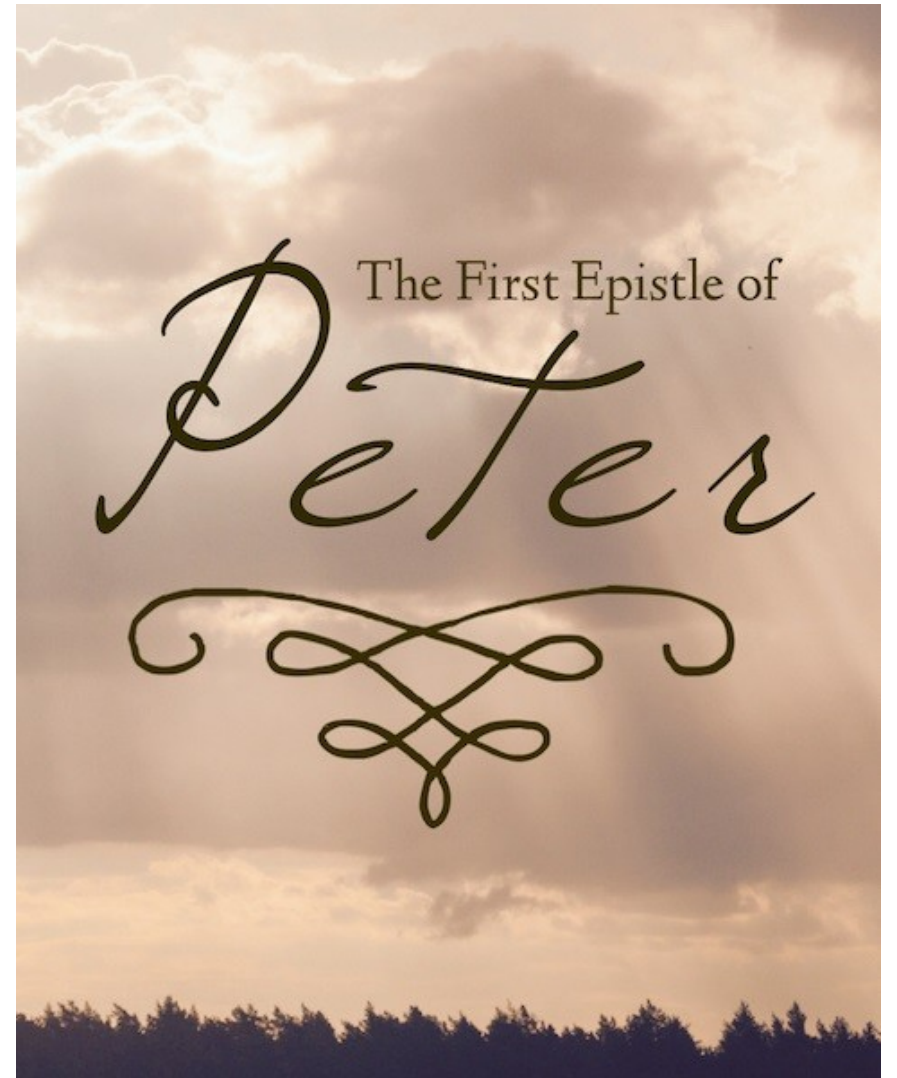

- 2. It is the works of a person that are to be judged.**
- 3. God will judge without partiality.**



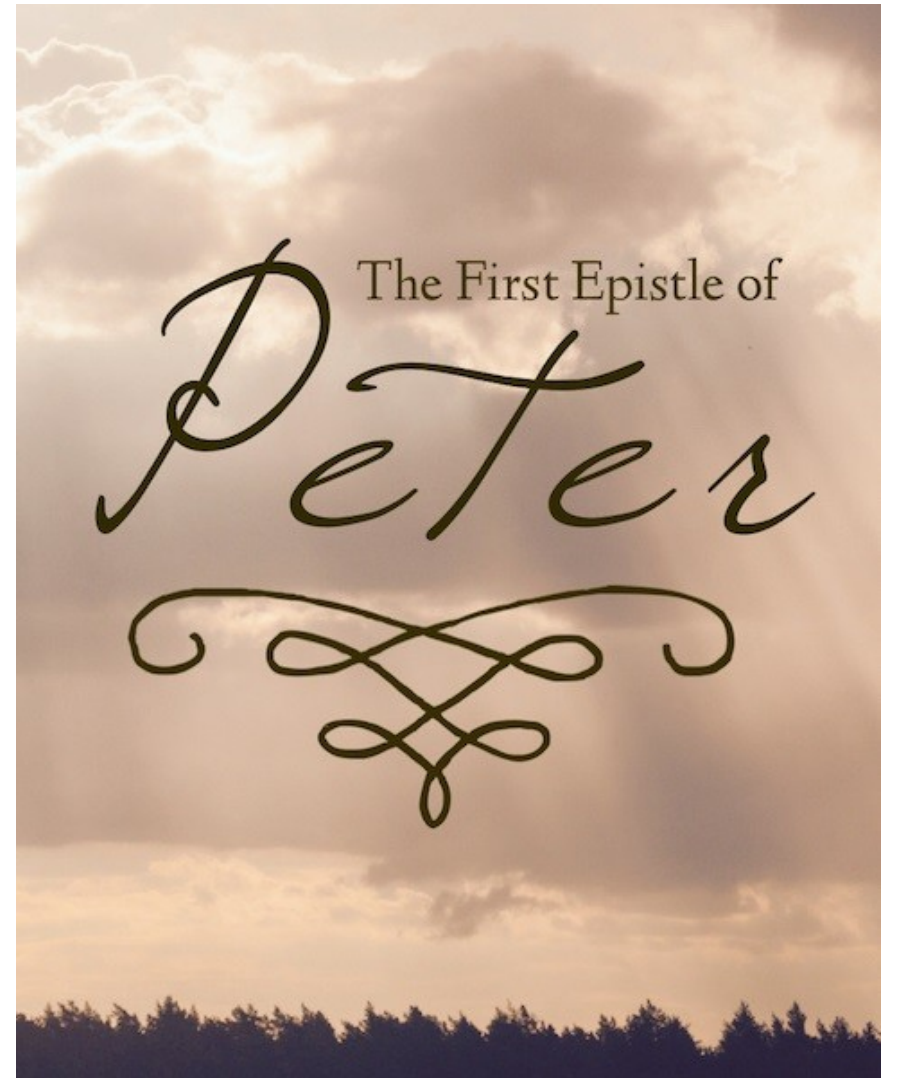

The word  
"redeem"  
(lutroō  
PWS: 3207 )

means to set  
free or deliver  
by paying  
some ransom.



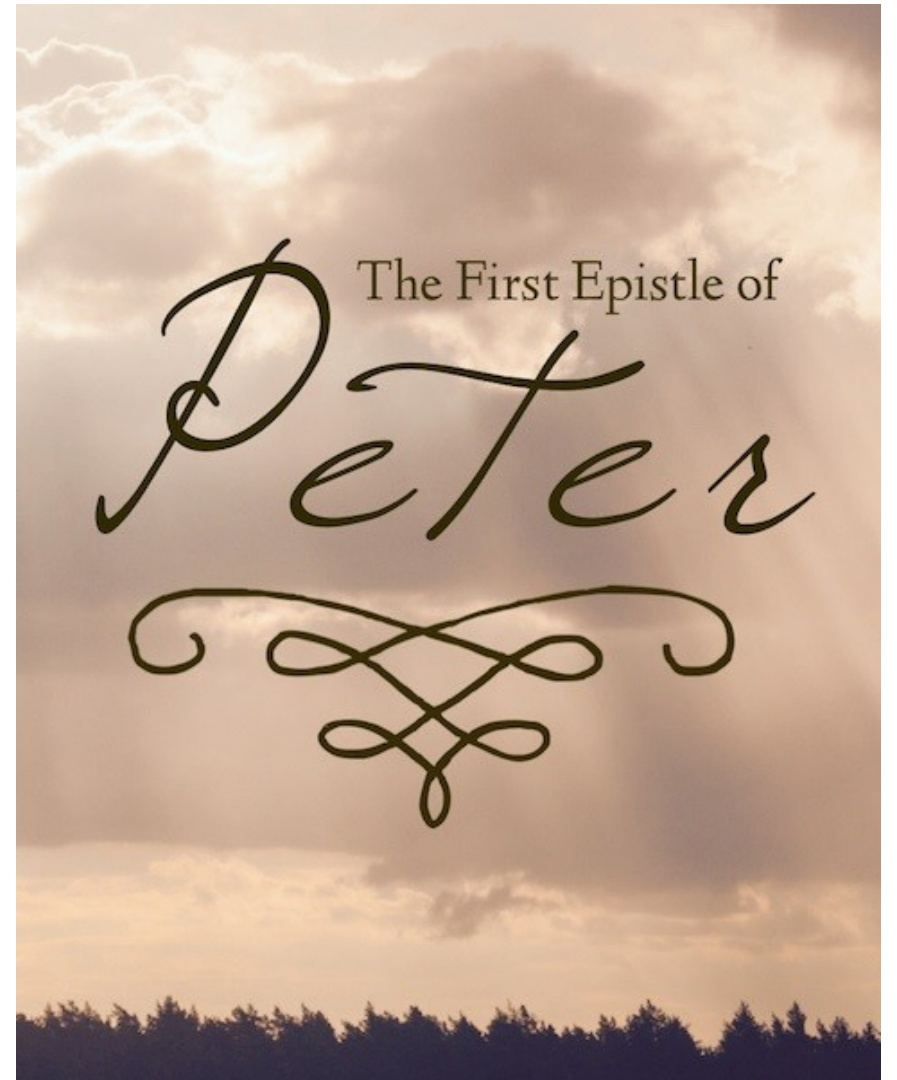
## **Note three significant points about Redemption.**

- 1. We need to be redeemed, to be set free from the empty life that we have been taught to live by our forefathers.**
- 2. We are freely redeemed: redemption does not cost us a penny.**
- 3. We are redeemed by the precious blood of Christ.**



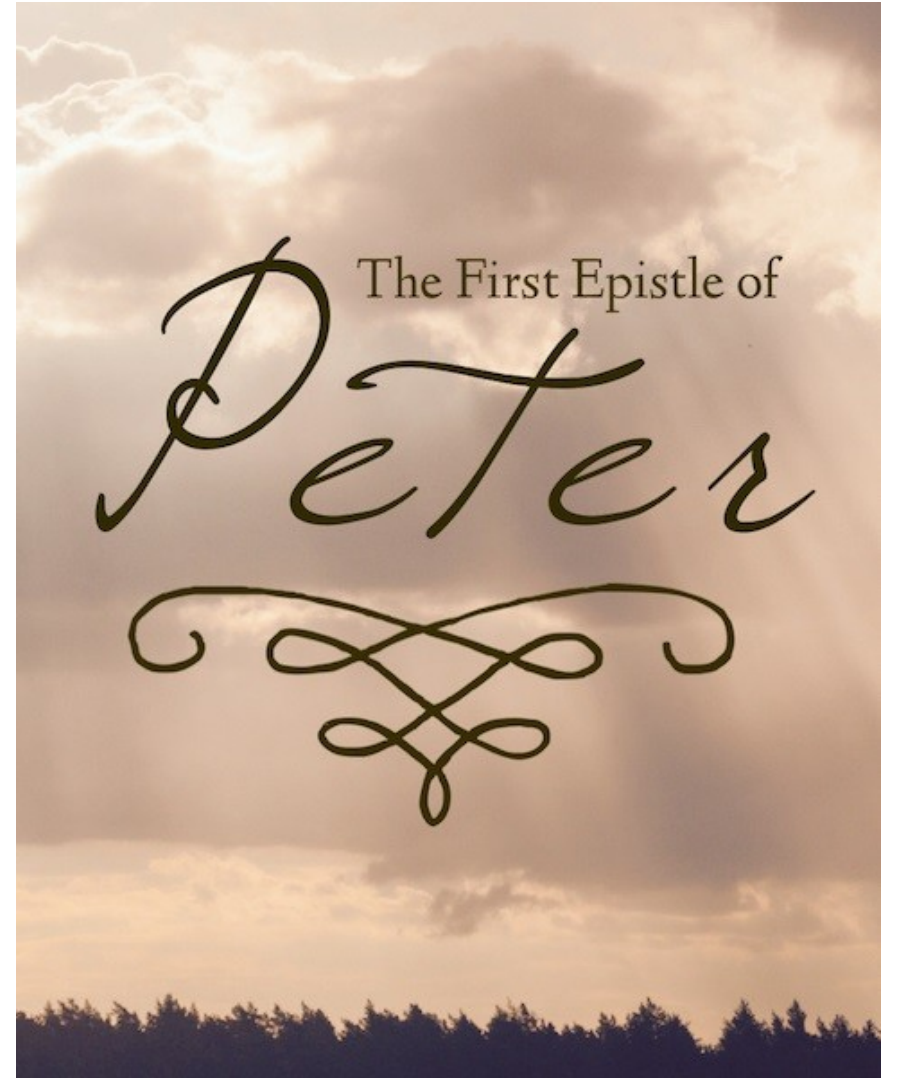
## 1 Peter 1:18 KJV

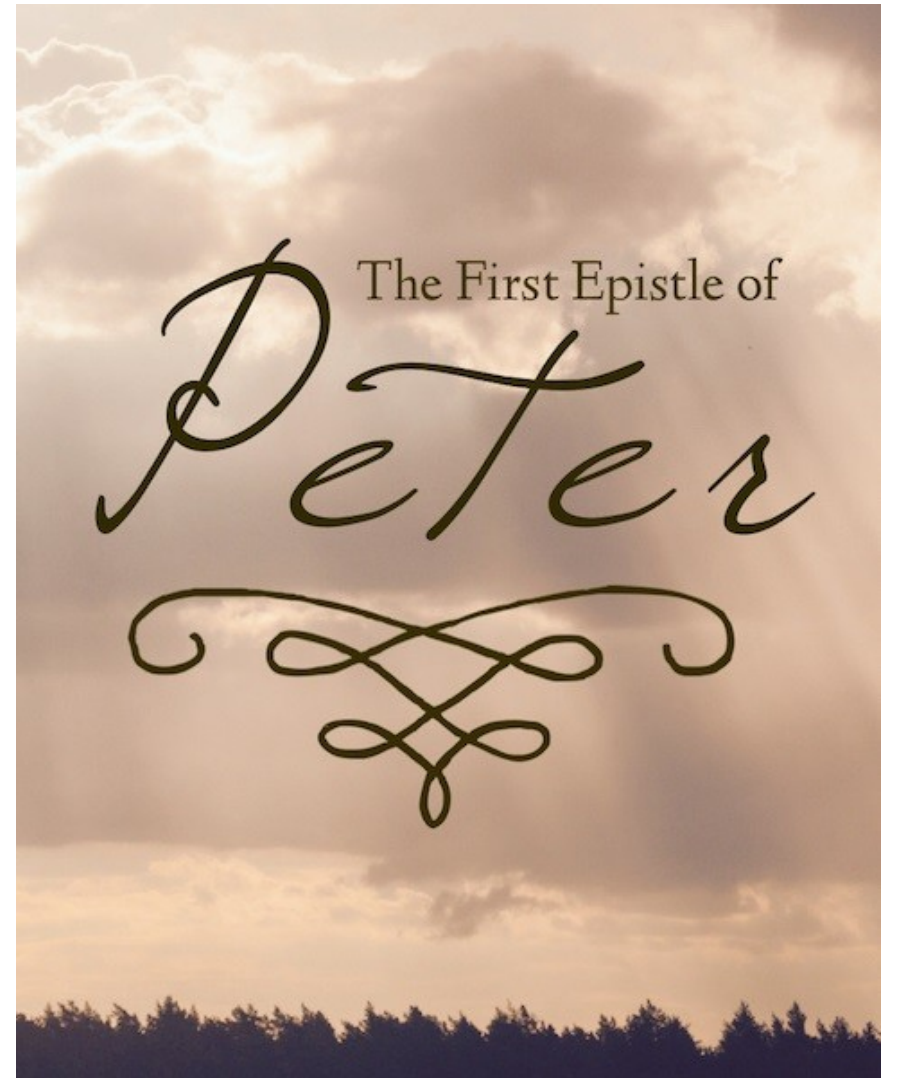

"The blood of anyone is 'precious' [**costly**] far above gold or silver, but that of Jesus immeasurably more so"



**Believers are to Reverence God**

**5. Because you believe in  
the God who raised up  
and glorified Christ (v.21).**

## How is it that the blood of Christ redeems us?

- a. First, Jesus Christ was just like the Passover lamb, "without blemish and without spot."**
  
- b. Second, God foreordained that Christ redeem us by His blood, foreordained it even before the foundation of the world.**
  
- c. Third, Christ has now come.**
