A faulty thinking pattern based on lies and deception, which gives Satan power in our lives

"Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?"

## Discerning Strongholds

- 1. You have a stronghold if your mind keeps focusing on a particular event from the past.
- 2. You have a stronghold if you are committed to a course of action contrary to Scripture.

3. You have a stronghold if you resist the Word of God.

#### Discerning Strongholds

4. You have a stronghold if you focus on the actions of others in order to defend your behavior.

5. You have a stronghold if you are defensive when biblically confronted by spiritual leaders.

6. You have a stronghold if your mind holds any unscriptural idea.
