

**Babylon: Great City Judged (part 2)**  
**Revelation 18:9-24**

*I. DECLARATION: "Fallen, fallen is Babylon" (vv.1-3)*

*II. DAMNATION: "pay her back...give back" (vv.4-8)*

**III. DESTRUCTION: "woe, woe, the great city" (vv.9-20)**

**A. Ungodly:** "will weep and lament over her" (vv.9-19)

1. Monarchs: "the kings of the earth" (vv.9-10)

2. Merchants: "the merchants of the earth" (vv.11-17a)

3. Mariners: "every shipmaster...passenger...sailor" (vv.17b-19)

**B. Godly:** "rejoice over her" (v.20)

1. Responsibility: "rejoice" (v.20a)

2. Extermination: "Fallen, fallen is Babylon" (v.20b)

**IV. DESOLATION: "Babylon...thrown down" (vv.21-24)**

**A. Example:** "a stone like a great millstone" (v.21)

1. Reflection: "took up a stone" (v.21a)

2. Reality: "Babylon...thrown down...found no longer" (v.21b)

**B. Extermination:** "will not be...any longer"(vv.22-23)

1. Results: "not be heard...found...shine any longer" (vv.22-23a)

2. Reason: "all nations were deceived by your sorcery" (v.23b)

**C. Evidence:** "in her...the blood...of all...slain" (v.24)

1. Revelation: "in her was found the blood" (v.24a)

2. Representatives: "the blood of prophets and of saints" (v.24b)
