- 1. What does this name mean?
- 2. What was the point of getting witnesses to verify the writing? How long after the writing was Isaiah's son born?
- 3. How long after his birth would Assyria wreak havoc?
- 4. The waters of Shiloah that flow gently referred to a small stream that flowed from the Gishon to Jerusalem as a part of the water supply to the city and represented the LORD as a source of help. What did the "River" (likely the Euphrates) refer to? Which did Israel trust in? Ahaz?
- 5. Read Hebrews 10:31-11:1. What would faith have looked like if Ahaz had committed himself to the LORD?
- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15. What is similar to the sparing of Judah from Assyria in this passage?
- 7. Why would the plans of Judah's enemies be thwarted?

The Unfaithful in Judah and the Remnant

- 1. What are unbelievers afraid of? What would they call "conspiracies?" Read Proverbs 1:7 and Job 28:28. Discuss.
- 2. How could the presence of God be one thing to unbelievers and another to believers?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 2:4-8. What is the difference between the stone in Isaiah and in 1 Peter? Why do some stumble?
- 4. Why do people seek out mediums? Is the point of verse 19 different from praying to saints for intercession?
- 5. How do we inquire of God? "To the law and to the testimony" is an urgent call to the remnant? How vital is it to heed this call? Review 2 Timothy 3:14-17 and discuss.
- 6. How serious is the condition of the reprobate in verses 20-22? Compare this to those in Romans 1:18-32.
