- 1. 2C a 'pathetic' epistle if Cors reject Paul, they reject Christ.
- 2. <u>5:9-11</u> 2 pts of ref: 1] death/FJ & 2] Cor's consc.
- 3. <u>v12-13</u> Cors accuse Paul of being crazy [A26:24]: if fanatical for God; when of *sound mind* for Cors.
 - i. sound mind = sane, think straight, use good sense, reasonable Rm 12:3
 - ii. The questions: what drives Paul? V14-15.

1st The Love of X

- 1. Is this our love for Christ or His love for us? Context: Jesus' death & res -> His love for us. What makes Paul appear to be crazy? Christ loves him?!?
- 2. To be loved by Jesus is overwhelming. Rm 8:37-39 [L.M. Lehman]
- 3. Particular & personal Gal 2:20 loved me & gave Himself up for me.
- 4. God's love: substance is the cross: 1Jn 4:9-10; Rm 8:31-35a

2nd: The Control of X

1. *controls* - to hold together, keep intact; pressure from all sides that direct to a specific point - gripped, under siege, restricted, imprisoned - com-

pelled by Scripture and HS to understand & experience being loved by Jesus.

2. The force pressing on & in Paul was Christ's indomitable [impossible to subdue] love for him.

Applic#1: What is the Compelling Force of Our Lives?

- 1. Consider *control* what drives you?
- 2. Perhaps an external force Rm 12:2 conformed = pressed into mold
- 3. Perhaps an internal force <u>2Pt 2:18,19</u> overcome = defeated & taken prisoner compulsions *fleshly desires*, sensuality, corruption -> enslaved.
- **4.** Ferguson: Jn called *the beloved* b/c Jn received Jesus' love. Does Christ love Paul more than He loves you? Eph 3:16-19
- 5. There is a greater force Jesus' love for you.
