Praise the Lord for His Love & Faithfulness: A Sabbath Song (Ps 92)

- This psalm is the only one specifically designated for the Sabbath day
- Its focus is on praising & thanking God morning and evening
- This psalm addresses the matter of our heart when we worship God

Worshiping God Every Day

- Every day we are to praise and give thanks to God every day
- The Masoretes had a psalm of worship for every day of the week

I. It Is Good to Give Thanks & Praise to God Ceaselessly (vv.1-4)

- Why is it good to praise God? (cf. Gen1: 4, 10, 12, 18, 21, 25, 31)
- The psalm speaks of the created work of God (vv.4-5)
- What should we praise God for? 1) Steadfast love 2) God's faithfulness
- How should we praise God? Joyfully (v 3) and with instruments (v.4)

II. The Senseless are Silent(vv.5-9)

- Psalmist contrast himself with the wicked: noting two key problems.
- 1. They are like senseless beasts
- 2. They are wicked in their beastlike behavior (vs. 7&9)

III. The Psalmist's Final Testimony (vv.12-15)

- Psalmist contrasts the way of the wicked with the way of the righteous
- 1. They will flourish like a palm tree/grow strong like a Lebanon cedar (12–13)
- 2. They will be fruitful even into old age (14)
- 3. Their testimony will remain firm to the very end of their lives (15)
