Unless the Lord Builds the House (Psalm 127)

- We are considering this text in light of Proverbs 6 and 7
- Solomon's positive encouragement: God builds our families.
- Family is the building block of society, if the family fails, society fails

II. The Foundation of a Blessed Family (127:1-2)

- A. What is necessary
- 1) The home must be built by the Lord (v.1)
 - "Unless the Lord builds the house."
- 2) The home must be protected by the Lord (v.1,2)
 - "Unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain"
- B. What is needless (v.2)
 - "It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrow"
 - "For so He gives his beloved sleep"

II. The Fruits from a Blessed Family (127: 3-5)

"Behold children are a heritage from the Lord the fruit of the womb is a reward."

- 1) Will honor their parents
- 2) A blessing to their parents and a preservative to a decaying world.
 - "Happy is the man who has his quiver fill of them;"
 - "They shall not be ashamed but shall speak with their enemies at the gate"

Be Anxious for Nothing (Philippians 4:6-7)

- Last message: "Rejoice in the Lord always" Phil 4:4,5
 - 1. The joy of the Lord (4:4)
 - 2. Gentleness before all men (4:5a)
 - 3. The Lord is at hand (4:5b)

I. Don't be Anxious, be in Prayer (4:6)

1) Be anxious for *nothing*

2) But in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving

II. God's Gift of Peace in Christ Jesus (4:7)

1) His peace – the peace of God

2) The peace of God that surpasses all understanding (*incomprehensible*)

Eph 3: 19 compared to the incomprehensible love of God

3) Will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus
