* Two Motives that Prevent us from Sinning

I. The <u>FEAR</u> of God (Prov.8:13; 16:6)

Proverbs 8:13

The fear of the Lord is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.

Proverbs 16:6

By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the Lord men depart from evil.

II. The <u>LOVE</u> of God (John 14:23-24; I John 5:3)

John 14:23-24

"...If a man love me, he will keep my words...He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings"

I John 5:3 - "For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous."

How do we obtain this Fear of God and Love for God? By Faith.
