 - John 8:24 "Unless you believe that <u>IAM</u> (Gr. ἐγώ εἰμι; cf. Exodus 3:14 in LXX), you will die in your sins" (NASB 2020).
 - John 8:58-59 "Jesus said to them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, <u>IAM</u>' (Gr. ἐγώ εἰμι). Then they took up stones to throw at Him" (NKJV).
 - b. Other Errors
 - i. No Crucifixion of Jesus (Surah 4:157)
 - ii. Mary a Member of the Trinity (Surah 5:116)
