# Improper speech, its source, and (-) effects

## I. Its Destructiveness

# A. To the speaker

- Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue. 18:21
- A *fool's* mouth *is* his destruction, and his lips *are* the snare of his soul. 18:7

#### B. To others

- [the city] is overthrown by the mouth of the *wicked*. 11:11
- The words of the *wicked* are to lie in wait for blood.... 12:6
- There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword. 12:18
- An *ungodly* man diggeth up evil: and in his lips *there is* as a burning fire. 16:27
- A *violent* man . . . moving his lips he bringeth evil to pass. 16:29-30

# II. Content - What Not To Say

# A. False Witness/Lying

- BE NOT <u>A WITNESS</u> against thy neighbour <u>without cause</u>; and <u>DECEIVE NOT</u> with thy lips. 24:28
- A man that beareth false witness against his neighbour is a maul, and a sword, and a sharp arrow. 25:18
- A <u>false witness</u> shall not be unpunished, and he that <u>speaketh lies</u> shall not escape. 19:5
- A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall perish. 19:9
- An <u>ungodly witness</u> scorneth judgment: 19:28
- These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: ... a lying tongue, ... a false witness that speaketh lies....6:16-19
- The getting of treasures by a <u>lying tongue</u> is a <u>vanity</u> tossed to and fro of *them that seek death*. 21:6
- ... a *false witness* will utter <u>lies</u>. 14:5
- ... a *deceitful witness* speaketh <u>lies</u>. 14:25
- A <u>false witness</u> shall <u>perish</u>: 21:28
- He that hideth hatred with lying lips . . . is a fool. 10:18

- Lying lips are abomination to the LORD: 12:22
- ... a lying tongue is but for a moment. 12:19
- A lying tongue hateth those that are afflicted by it. 26:28

#### B. Slander

- <u>DEBATE THY CAUSE</u> with thy neighbour himself; and <u>DISCOVER NOT A SECRET</u> to another: Lest he that heareth it put thee to shame, and thine infamy turn not away. 25:9-10
- He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: 20:19
- ...he that <u>repeateth a matter</u> separateth very friends. 17:9
- The words of a <u>talebearer</u> are as <u>wounds</u>, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly. 18:8; 26:22
- A talebearer revealeth secrets. 11:13
- ... a whisperer separateth chief friends. 16:28
- ... he that uttereth a slander, is a fool. 10:18

# C. Perversity

- PUT AWAY from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips PUT FAR FROM THEE. 4:24
- ... the mouth of the *wicked* speaketh frowardness. 10:32
- ... the <u>froward</u> tongue shall be <u>cut out.</u> 10:31
- ... he that hath a <u>perverse</u> tongue falleth into mischief. 17:20
- ... perverseness therein [the tongue] is a breach in the spirit. 15:4

## D. Pride

- LET ANOTHER MAN <u>PRAISE</u> THEE, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips. 27:2
- If thou hast done foolishly in <u>lifting up thyself</u>, or if thou hast thought evil, *LAY* THINE HAND UPON THY MOUTH. 30:32
- In the mouth of the *foolish* is a rod of <u>pride</u>: 14:3

## E. Hypocrisy

- He that *hateth* <u>dissembleth</u> with his lips, and *layeth up deceit* within him; When he <u>speaketh</u> <u>fair</u>, BELIEVE HIM NOT: for there are *seven abominations in his heart*. 26:24-25
- An *hypocrite* with his mouth destroyeth his neighbour: 11:9

# F. Flattery

- MEDDLE NOT with him that <u>flattereth</u> with his lips. 20:19
- A man that <u>flattereth</u> his neighbour spreadeth a net for his feet. 29:5
- ...a <u>flattering</u> mouth worketh ruin. 26:28

#### G. Foolishness

• ... the mouth of *fools* poureth out foolishness15:2

# III. <u>Manner - How Not To Say It</u>

# A. Loquacious

- In the <u>multitude of words</u> there wanteth not sin: 10:19
- ... a <u>prating</u> *fool* shall <u>fall</u>. 10:8,10
- ... the <u>talk of the lips</u> tendeth only to penury. 14:23
- ... he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction. 13:3
- A fool uttereth all his mind: 29:11

## B. Loud

 He that blesseth his friend with a <u>loud voice</u>, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him. 27:14

#### C. Contentious

• A *fool's* lips enter into <u>contention</u>, and his mouth <u>calleth for strokes</u>. 18:6

## D. Hurtful

• ... grievous words stir up anger. 15:1

# IV. Timing - When Not To Sav It

## A. Hasty

• Seest thou a man that is <u>hasty in his words</u>? there is <u>more hope of a fool</u> than of him. 29:20

## B. Without listening

• He that <u>answereth a matter before he heareth</u> it, it is folly and shame unto him. 18:13

# V. Audience – Who Not To Speak To

• SPEAK NOT in the ears of a fool: for he will despise the wisdom of thy words. 23:9
