## **Application Questions**

- 1. Read **Philippians 3:7-9**. Why is a clear understanding of passages like this so important before there is any discussion of the "fruit" of good works in the Christian life?
- 2. Read **James 2:14-26**. Explain in your own words why this emphasized aspect of saving faith does not contradict Philippians 3:7-9.
- 3. Read **Matthew 7:15-20**. Though some will claim that the teaching about the relationship between faith and good works should only be utilized for one's own self-evaluation, why does Jesus insist that we consider it a standard of measure for the lives of others as well? In what other situations might this also be important?

4. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17**. Consider your own life and describe some of the obvious changes that were affected from the inside out when you became a Christian.

5. Read **Proverbs 28:13-14**. When regenerate people do sin, how is their response noticeably different than when unregenerate people sin?
