LOVE AND LIGHT

Ephesians 5:1-14

- **I. LOVE** (1-2; 1 Jn 4:7-12)
 - **A. God is Love**. (1 Jn 4:8, 16
 - B. We are God's Beloved Children. (1 Jn 3:1 & 4:7)—Imitate Him.
 - 1. Recipients of God's Love —We have been loved, so we know how.
 - 2. Family Resemblance—families have a look and feel about them
 - C. Live a Life of Love.—walk like Jesus
 - 1. <u>Different Types of Love</u>—categories—What kind of love is it?
 - **2.** <u>Appropriate and Inappropriate Love</u> (1 Jn 2:15; Ps 78:58; Hos 4:18; Ezek 23;7)—morality; some "loves" are *disordered*
 - **3.** <u>God's Love</u>—faithful loving-kindness; committed to doing what right and best for the one who is loved, even at great cost to self
 - **4.** <u>Christ's Example</u>—gave Himself up for us (self-sacrifice)
 - a. Fragrant Offering ()—
 - **b. Sacrifice** *to God* (Rom 12:1)—God is the object of our worship
- II. NOT LOVE (3-5)—what is appropriate behavior for God's children
 - **A.** <u>Inappropriate</u>—not even a hint
 - 1. Sexual Immorality and Impurity—unrestrained sexual behavior (external actions)
 - **2. Covetousness**—inward insatiable greed for selfish gratification (internal attitude, matter of the heart)
 - **3. Indecent Talk**—obscenity, foolish talk, coarse joking about sex; (verbal expression of what is in the heart)
 - B. <u>Instead Thanksgiving</u> (Col 3:17)
 - 1. Attitude of **Gratitude** rather than Greed
 - 2. Focus on God rather than Self
 - **3. Gracious Conversation**—honorable, appropriate, considerate, appreciative—not vulgar, degrading, suggestive, inciting lust

III. REALITY CHECK (5-7)

- A. Consequences of Sin—(Rev 22:15)
 - **1.** <u>No Inheritance</u> in Christ's Kingdom—no reward, no eternal life, not part of Christ's kingdom (impostors)
 - 2. God's Wrath upon the Wicked—judgment, punishment, destruction—
- **B.** <u>Denial of Judgment</u> (Dan 11:32; 2 Thes 2:9-12; 2 Pet 3:3-7; Jude 1:5-7)
 - **1. Deception**—*warned* of false prophets and false teachers
 - 2. Empty Words—insincere, aren't true, shouldn't be trusted
- IV. <u>LIGHT</u> (8-14)—openness, transparency, nothing to hide
 - A. Children of Light (Jam 1:17; 1 Jn 1:5)—identity, essence, character
 - B. Fruit of Light (9-10)
 - 1. Goodness—can imply generosity, being good to others
 - **2. Righteousness**—justice, integrity
 - **3. Truth**—not lies or false reality
 - C. <u>Works of Darkness</u> (12;)—ignorance, error, evil
 - 1. <u>Unfruitful</u>—don't produce what you hope for; not beneficial
 - 2. <u>Secret</u>—Darkness hides evil
 - 3. Shameful—victim not shameful—abuser is!
 - **D.** Power of Light (13-14; Jn 3:19)—deeds of darkness fear the light of exposure
 - **1. Reveals** —shows what is there.
 - 2. Cleanses—makes atmosphere inhospitable to deeds of darkness
 - **E. Duty of Light** (11; Mat 5:14-16)—how to live as children of light
 - 1. **Do not participate**. ()—do not be partners with them
 - 2. Expose them. ()—This requires COURAGE!
 - "Silence in the face of evil is itself evil: God will not hold us guiltless. Not to speak is to speak. Not to act is to act." (D. Bonhoeffer)
