4. Read 2 Peter 3:10-13 and Hebrews 11:8-16. What steps can you take to strengthen your anticipation and affections for the next life?

5. Read Colossians 3:1-4. How would you instruct and counsel a young Christian who asks you how he can live out the truth of this passage well?
