THE FOUR TYPES OF HEARERS OF THE WORD (2)

I. Way-side Hearer: (4, 19) unprepared and unresponsive heart

II. Stony-ground hearer (vs. 5-6, 20-21): *impulsive heart*

- A. Stony-ground hearers must not be confused with 3^{rd} type
 - 1. Example of stony-ground hearers:
 - a. what attracted them in Jesus is not His works as salvation from sin
 - b. therefore cost of real discipleship was too high

III. Thorny-ground hearer (7, 22; Luke 8:14): *the halting – 2-minded hearer*

- A. Jesus picture in this hearer an outward Christian without real fruit
 - 1. They are church going people who show Christian traits in talk and walk a. though the Word takes root but fails to bear fruit
 - 2. Jesus identifies what prevent the Word from producing saving fruit a. thorns and thistles choke but don't kill the plant
 - b. so many outward Christians choke the Word to bear fruit because of their pre-occupations with the earthly: *cares riches pleasures*
 - 3. If you keep living like that, your name is Esau: Hebrews 12:16-17

IV. Good-ground hearer (Matt. 13:23; Luke 8:15) meditating responsive hearer

- A. Jesus pictures those
 - 1. who hears and understands the Word (Matt:13:23)
 - 2. who hears and receives the Word (Mark 4:20)
 - 3. who hears and keeps the Word (Luke 8:15)
- B. What do you do with the Word because all do something with the Word?
- C. Good ground hearer is *only fruitful hearer* though not all are equally fruitful
- D. What fruits will be found in a good heart that heeds the Word of God?
