The foundational truth of Hebrews 4:14–5:10

Jesus is our “great high priest.”

A priest is a mediator between God and people.

Throughout the Old Testament, God taught people that the only way he could be approached was at the temple he designed, through an animal sacrifice he required, offered by a priest that he had appointed.

The foundational truth of Hebrews 4:14–5:10

Jesus is our “great high priest.”

4:14-16 – The risen, exalted King is our sympathetic high priest at God’s throne.

5:1-10 – Like priests throughout the Old Testament (verses 1-4), the Messiah is appointed by God and compassionate toward the weak (verses 5-10). But he’s *much* better!
