

Take Heart: Jesus is the Way – Women Discipling Women
John 14. 1-14

*“Older women are to teach what is good and so train the young women ...
so that the word of God may not be reviled.”*
Titus 2:3

I. Take Heart! Your Home is Secure! (vs. 1-6)

- *Where do you find home & security?*
- *What is the thing that, if you had it, everything would be great?
And if you lost it - everything would fall apart?*

II. Rejoice! You have a new family! (vs. 7-11)

- *How can you be thankful for & extend grace to your family?*

III. Work Hard! Your Rest Has Come! (vs. 12-14)

1. “In Jesus name”
2. “For God’s glory”
3. Through God’s power

- *Who could you meet with to share what you are learning in
God’s word?*

Discipleship Principles:

- Jesus is more concerned with the heart than with behavior.
- Jesus directs people to himself.
- What you learn from God’s word about Jesus, share with someone else.

John 14. 1-14 (English Standard Version)

“Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me.
² In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. ⁴ And you know the way to where I am going.” ⁵ Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?” ⁶ Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. ⁷ If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.”

⁸ Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.” ⁹ Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? ¹⁰ Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. ¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

¹² “Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father. ¹³ Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.
