Responsive Confession:

WSC 88-90

Elder: What are the outward means whereby Christ communicates to us the benefits of redemption?

Congregation: The outward and ordinary means whereby Christ communicates to us the benefits of redemption, are His ordinances, especially the Word, sacraments, and prayer; all which are made effectual to the elect for salvation.


SERMON NOTES
