"For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong men have been slain by her." (Prov. 7:26)

Though the Scripture indicates that the \_\_\_\_\_ are seducible, some would insist otherwise:

With regard to digital technology, there are several areas with which, we MUST be aware of danger. Last week, we focused on the perils of the internet. This week, we will focus on \_\_\_\_\_\_ with a emphasis on what is said and interacted with.

Social media sites are some of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ visited sites on the internet. They are often interacted through \_\_\_\_\_\_ device apps. Some of the most popular social media apps are: Facebook (Meta), YouTube, Instagram, TikTok, Snapchat, X (Twitter) Pinterest, Reddit, and Linkedin. Some internet \_\_\_\_\_\_ allow for player interaction and should be considered social media at some level. It should be noted that users can interact with these sites differently. Some of the follow-ing perils will at times be directed more toward one than the other.

- The Peril of Dangerous \_\_\_\_\_\_ These words stop at nothing to criticize, \_\_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_. It is said, "Sticks and stones may brake my bones, but words can never hurt me." This is an interesting rhyme, but it is not \_\_\_\_\_\_. Many a \_\_\_\_\_\_ rumor or lie has been the ruination of someone. Death and Life are in the power of the tongue (Prov. 18.21).
- 2) The Peril of \_\_\_\_\_\_ Those that seek to \_\_\_\_\_ the child/youth/ adult through \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ and ensnare them to illicit activity. Social media is not home to only innocent children. There are those that seek to \_\_\_\_\_ the heart of a curious child and seek to lure them into

destruction (Prov. 7.13; 30.19,20). There was a time when children were instructed to not talk to strangers. Yet, on the social media sites every one is a \_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_.

- 3) The Peril of \_\_\_\_\_\_ It is a foolish thing to compare oneself to another (II Cor. 10.12). Yet, in the realm of social media comparisons can take a front row seat. This is especially true of some of the social media influencers and commentors that constantly tell you what you \_\_\_\_\_\_ to have or what you shouldn't have in order to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ (accepted).
- 4) The Peril of Personal \_\_\_\_\_\_ with Self (Body Image) Recent polling from the UK of over 5,500 people conveyed that 73% of \_\_\_\_\_\_ where impacted (from disgust to shame). Of the same adult sample, 13% felt so hopeless that they considered suicide. While 68% of teenagers were impacted. Those immersed into the social media world become trapped into a myopic point of view that \_\_\_\_\_\_ them from experiencing some of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of life. (Prov. 4.23, Psa. 16.11).
- 5) The Perils of Online \_\_\_\_\_(Challenges) While dares are common among the youth, the unsupervised perils of the social media challenges have brought \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ to some youth. These challenges include the following: the Benadryl challenge, Blackout challenge, Deodorant challenge, etc. Once again, to those immersed in social media it seems "everyone" is engaging in these \_\_\_\_\_\_of dangerous foolishness. - 6) The Perils of \_\_\_\_\_\_ It is true that many go to certain social media sites for information direction— YouTube, Reddit. However, there \_\_\_\_\_ and will \_\_\_\_\_\_ to be an unfiltered, ungovernable stream of \_\_\_\_\_\_ from the internet/social media. If you think that at times you don't know what to believe, imagine the trouble this causes for youth—that already know everything (Prov. 3.5, 4.7).
- Perils of \_\_\_\_\_\_ In extreme cases, the overall health of some is compromised. Be that from a challenge, \_\_\_\_\_\_, dieting, mental anguish, or \_\_\_\_\_\_. The prolonged unfiltered influence of social media can have a devastating impact on those that are enticed by it (Prov. 2.20-22).
