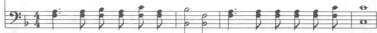
## What a Friend We Have in Jesus

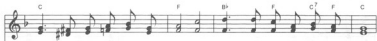
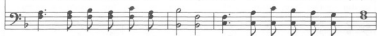
*Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. Phil. 4:6*
