Trials and Temptations

Lacking nothing:

Trial: At first glance looks undesirable, but can lead to something good.

► A trial, rightly handled, enhances our walk of faith.

Temptation: At first glance looks desirable, but can lead to something terrible.

- ► A temptation, wrongly handled, impairs our walk of faith and leads to sin.
- ► God never tempts a believer to sin.
