- 2. Read **Jeremiah 1:5-8** and **Isaiah 46:8-11**. What would you say to someone who admits God plans out the big issues in history, but doesn't believe he providentially plans the path for the lives of everyday Christians like us?
- 3. Read **Psalm 119:14-16**. How would you explain to a new Christian the way God uses the study, reflection, and application of the Bible to direct our path into investments in our lives, which looking back years down the road can clearly be seen as God's specific and strategic will for our lives?
- 4. Read **1 Peter 4:1-2**. How have you found that episodes or seasons of suffering in your life (which you would have *never* chosen for yourself) end up being God's chosen preparation for helping you to fruitfully walk in the center of God's will?
- 5. Read Romans 8:28. How do you think God intended to impact us by including this verse in his word?
