Nehemiah, part 11: "God's People Confess Their Sins" Nehemiah 9:1-3

God's work of revival continues - and deepens!

1. The Gathering for Confession of Sin

"Now on the twenty-fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, in sackcloth, and with dust on their heads."

(1) 24th day of Tishri

- Two days after the celebration of the Feast of Booths

- (2) This gathering has all the markings of Yom Kippur the Day of Atonement
 - But Yom Kippur was to be held on the 10th day of Tishri!
 - What to make of this?
 - There was apparently a spontaneity about it.
 - This is a time of revival and this (confession of sin) is one of the marks of true revival.
 - It comes immediately on the heels of a time of great joy great rejoicing! So resting and rejoicing in God's mercy prepares the heart for deeper confession!

2. The Features of Confession of Sin

(1) A Sorrowing

- "the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, in sackcloth, and with dust on their heads."
- A sorrowing over sin personal and of the nation
- The accoutrements of sorrow in that day:

Fasting – the setting aside of bodily needs and pleasure for the sake of focus upon needs spiritual

Sackcloth – clothing of rough texture, of plain color, and untailored cut – a debasing oneself

Dust on the head – expression of humbling, debasing oneself because of sin

- (2) Separation from the World
- "Then those of Israelite lineage separated themselves from all foreigners; and they stood and confessed their sins and the sins of their fathers."
- Only those of the covenant nation!Emblematic of this:
 - The world does not, cannot share in this!
 - It is holy; it is sacred

- (3) Personal and Corporate Sin Confessed
 - cf. the prayer which follows vv. 4-37
- "they stood and confessed their sins and the sins of their fathers."

- (4) Unhurried!
 - A real indicator of revival!

"And they stood in their place and read from the Book of the Law of the LORD their God for one-fourth of the day; and for another fourth they confessed and worshiped the LORD their God."

- (5) Prompted, Directed by the Word of God
- (6) Joined with True Worship
