 - A. Word about Jesus was spreading.
 - B. Jesus taught them about the kingdom from Isaiah
 - C. The mission from the sermon
 - D. This is fulfilled in your hearing
- II. The Hearers Doubt About The Messenger and Confusion about the Message (22-30)
 - A. All were speaking well of Him
 - B. They doubted His position – “Is this not Joseph’s son?”
 - C. Jesus shows them the fulness of the message
 - D. This enraged the people of the synagogue
- III. The Global Nature of the Gospel
 - A. The kingdom of God is not for any one race or nation-state
 - B. The kingdom of God has always been open to the foreigner, stranger, and sojourner.
 - C. Mankind is united in its condemnation under Adam – Jesus is the new and better Adam
