Cleansed by the Humble King John 13:2-11

Main Point:

Make sure you are cleansed of all your sin by the humble King.

1. Jesus is the exalted Son of God and Son of Man.

2. Yet, Jesus humbled Himself to cleanse His people.

- 3. You need to receive Jesus' cleansing to share in His salvation.
- 4. You also need to receive Jesus' cleansing for your daily defilement.
- 5. Make sure you are cleansed of all your sin by the humble King.

- **John 1:1** 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (NKJV)
- **John 17:5** 5 And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was. (NKJV)
- **Daniel 7:13-14** 13 "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, *One* like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. 14 Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him ... (NKJV)
- **Luke 22:27** 27 For who *is* greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? *Is* it not he who sits at the table? Yet I am among you as the One who serves. (NKJV)

- **1 John 1:7-9** 7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. 8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
