#### Genesis 3:7, 10

<sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were *naked*. And they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths. ...

<sup>10</sup> ...“I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was *naked*, and I hid myself.”

#### Hebrews 4:12-13

<sup>12</sup> For *the word of God* is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, ... discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. <sup>13</sup> And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are **naked** and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

#### Revelation 3:17

For **you say**, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, *not realizing* that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and *naked*.

### III. Curse of the Serpent & Satan

#### A. The Curse of the Serpent

##### Genesis 3:14

The Lord God said to the serpent, “Because you have done this, **cursed are you** above all livestock...*on your belly* you shall go, and *dust you shall eat* ...

##### Micah 7:17 (Cf. Ps. 72:9; Isa. 49:23)

...they [the nations] shall *lick the dust like a serpent*, like the crawling things of the earth; they shall come trembling out of their strongholds...

#### B. The Curse of Satan/The 1<sup>st</sup> Gospel

##### Genesis 3:15

I will put **enmity** *between you and the woman*, and between *your offspring* and *her offspring*; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.”

### IV. The Judgment/Mercy Given Adam & Eve

#### A. The Judgment/Mercy to the Woman

##### Genesis 3:16

To the woman he said, “I will surely **multiply** your *pain* in *childbearing*; in *pain* you shall *bring forth children*. ... (Cont. p. 3)  
*Your desire shall be for your husband*, and **he shall rule over you**.”

#### B. The Judgment/Mercy to the Man

##### Genesis 3:17-19

<sup>17</sup> And to Adam he said, “Because you have *listened to the voice of your wife* **and** have eaten of the tree of which *I commanded you* ‘You shall not eat of it,’ **cursed is the ground** because of you; in *pain you shall eat* of it all the days of your life; <sup>18</sup> *thorns and thistles* . ... <sup>19</sup> till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; **for you are dust, and to dust you shall return**.” (Eternal Death – Rev. 14:9-11; 20:14-15)

### V. Repentance & Mercy

#### A. Faith – Believing God’s Word

##### Genesis 3:20

The man called his wife’s name Eve, because she was the mother of all living.

#### B. Clothing for Our Nakedness

##### Genesis 3:21

And **the Lord God made** for Adam and for his wife *garments of skins and clothed them*.

##### Psalms 32:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose *sin is covered*. ...

<sup>5</sup> I acknowledged my sin to you, and **I did not cover** my iniquity; I said, “I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,” and **you forgave** the iniquity of my sin.

#### C. Cut off from the Garden

##### Genesis 3:23-24

<sup>23</sup> therefore the Lord God *sent him out from the garden of Eden to work the ground* from which he was taken. <sup>24</sup> *He drove out the man*, and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the **cherubim** (e.g. Ezekiel 10; Holy of Holies) and a *flaming sword* that turned every way to guard the way to the **tree of life**.

##### Revelation 3:18-21

<sup>18</sup> I counsel you to buy **from me** gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich, and **white garments** so that you may *clothe yourself and the shame of your nakedness may not be seen*, and salve to anoint your eyes, so that you may see. <sup>19</sup> Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent. <sup>20</sup> Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him
