Proverbs 4:1–4

"How a Father Should Teach, and How His Children Should Listen"

- ¹ Hear, my children, the instruction of a father, And give attention to know understanding;
- For I give you good doctrine:
 Do not forsake my law.
- ³ When I was my father's son, Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother,
- ⁴ He also taught me, and said to me:
 "Let your heart retain my words;
 Keep my commands, and live.

Pastor teaches his family a selection from "the Proverb of the day." In these four verses of Holy Scripture, the Holy Spirit teaches us that a father should teach his children from the Bible, and the children should hear as listening to their heavenly Father, with the whole person for the whole life.

And then there are there's what we do after We are listening, do not forsake. My law. He says And we'll come back to that and let your heart retain.

My words. So if our father, and if those others whom the lord has appointed to us because it's the father in the home. The husband and the home. Um, But in the church of course it's the elders, the pastor teachers, Whom the lord. Jesus has given from heaven having ascended on high and given gifts among men.

That if the lord has given us, Specific people by whom he addresses us with his word then he wants us to be meditating upon thinking about turning over thinking about, well, what does that mean for my life? What do i need to believe? What do i need to stop?

Believing what do i need to stop? Feeling? What do i need to do and stop doing? What do i need to feel? Um, How does that connect to the other things? That the lord has been teaching me through my dad and through my pastor through my elders. And so you retain in your heart and you practice, Uh, what sometimes is called christian meditation.

Making the habit of your mind. To be to dwell upon the word of god, generally. And then specifically The word of god. As it is being opened to you. By those whom the lord has given you to do. So, So, Uh, while you're being instructed, you're here and give attention.

Uh, once you're done being instructed, after you're being instructed, you do not forsake but retain And then. The fact that it is do not forsake my law. And let your heart retain my words. Keep my commands and live. You may have actually picked up already that when we were talking about christian meditation.

Uh when i was talking about retaining, it in your hearts it was doing and stopping doing and feeling and stopping feeling and thinking and stopping thinking And that's the last part is we are to apply. God's word in our lives. We are to keep His commands and live. We are not to forsake.

His law. And this is, What a father must teach his children. This is what children must do. With their small, their father's words. And you may one day. No longer have a father to teach you. But you still have a heavenly father, who teaches you from his word. Do you still have the sun?

The lord jesus. Who is the word? And to addresses you especially in the preaching, You still have the holy spirit who is always with you. To bring to mind, and Make fertile and fruit fertile, your heart and fruitful has worked in your heart, and in your life. And these things as they apply in a small way to your earthly father Of course, they apply in the great way.
