## 1. His \_\_\_\_\_\_ to Earth, v.16a

A. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of His Incarnation: "God was manifest in the flesh"

B. The \_\_\_\_\_ by the Holy Spirit: "justified in the Spirit"

Romans 1:4: And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: (Jesus Christ our LORD). (Ephesians 1:18-20)

**C. The** \_\_\_\_\_\_ by angels: "seen of angels"

Acts 1:11; ...this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven.
