1. The Return of Christ Will Come at an Unknown Time (vv 1-3)

- A. Christ will come again at an unknown time.
 - 1) As a thief in the night
 - a) What this does not mean: not secretly. (4:16)
 - **b)** What this does mean: unexpected and unwanted (v 3)
 - 2) You have no need
 - a) The example of Christ's incarnation (Gal 4:4-5).
 - **b)** The teaching of Scripture that the judgement of God comes on a day unknown (Isa 13:8-9; Mt 24:42-44; 2 Pt 3:10)
- **B.** Yet there are times and seasons before Christ's coming
 - 1) As with the incarnation of Christ (Dan 2:44, 9:24)
 - 2) So with Christ's coming, there are times and seasons:
 - a) The Destruction of the Temple in AD 70 (Mk 13:1-2)
 - **b)** The revealing of the Man of Sin (2 Thes 2:3)
 - c) The destruction of all of Christ's enemies (Rev 16:19)
 - **d)** Great Gospel expansion throughout the nations, so that the number of all who are elected for salvation is fulfilled (Isa 2:2; Psa 72:8).
 - e) Satan's final defeat at Christ's return (Rev 20:7, 9)
- C. Yet for many, they will not be looking for His coming
 - 1) Being content in themselves (Heb 9:27; Psa 115:8 Jer 8:11)
 - 2) Yet once destruction comes, it is inescapable (Lk 16:23-24)
- **D.** Uses from the Text
 - **1)** We are not to seek to know the day of Christ's coming.
 - 2) We are to be humble, recognizing we are not guaranteed tomorrow. (Jms 4:14-15)
 - 3) We are to have our hope in Christ alone for our salvation.
 - **4)** We are to be discerning of the times in which we live.
 - 5) The Church is to have a different understanding of peace and safety than the world (Psa 122:7)

11. The Church is to be Watchful for Christ's Return (vv 4-5)

A. Christians are not to be caught off-guard at Christ's return, as the wicked will be.

- **1)** Because we are neither in darkness nor in the night, as those outside the Church
 - a) We are not to be in the darkness of ignorance (I Cor 2:14).
 - **b)** We are not caught up in the darkness of sin (Eph 5:8
 - c) We are not asleep in the dark of night (Jn 11:11-14, 39-44)
- 2) Because we are of the light and of the day
 - **a)** We are to have remembrance of these things (Psa 119:130; Dt 6:7)
 - **b)** We are to be walking in righteousness, with clear conscience before the Lord (1 Jn 2:8, 10)
 - **c)** We are to be awake, vigilant (Jdg 7:5-6).
- **B.** Uses from the Text

 - 4) The Helmet of the Hope of Salvation
 - a) The hope of salvation guards our thoughts from despair (Phil 1:21)

 - c) The hope of salvation guards our ears from falsehood (Pr 17:3-4, ESV).
- **D.** Cling to the hope of the Gospel (vv 9-10; Rom 8:29-30)
- **E.** Comfort one another with the reminder of Christ's return (v 11a)
- **F.** Edify one another with the hope of Christ's return (v 11a)
- **G.** We are to grow in the graces already given us (v 11b)
 - **1)** For some, this is a needed instruction
 - 2) For some, this is a needed exhortation (Mt 25:1-13)
 - **3)** For some, this is an encouragement (Lk 2:25; Song of Songs 8:14).
