LIVING IN A SINFUL WORLD BEING SERVANTS OF THE LORD PHILIPPIANS 2:19-30

Introduction

If you've been in **CHURCH** any amount of time, you've probably come across some of the **LORD'S CHOICEST SERVANTS** who have made a **GREAT AND LASTING IMPACT** upon a **CHURCH** that you were a part of, the lives of others, and even your own life.

Even as I say those words, faces of certain individuals in each CHURCH I've been associated with come to mind! I've been BLESSED to have some VERY SPECIAL PEOPLE TOUCH and INFLUENCE my own life in GREAT and LASTING WAYS through their SERVICE FOR THE LORD!

I have been **BLESSED** to have been around some **SPECIAL FOLKS** who displayed the **PRESENCE OF GOD** in their lives and were a **GREAT BLESSING** to those whose lives they touched.

Understand that I'm not just talking about **PREACHERS** or even **TEACHERS**, but about some folks who were some of the **LORD'S CHOICEST SERVANTS** even though they may not have been in the limelight.

In our text this morning we're going to see two SPECIAL SERVANTS OF THE LORD who were of tremendous HELP to the APOSTLE PAUL and SERVED THE LORD JESUS CHRIST FAITHFULLY— TIMOTHY (or TIMOTHEUS) and EPAPHRODITUS.

READ THE TEXT.

It is believed that **PAUL** first met **TIMOTHY** on his first missionary journey. **TIMOTHY** is first mentioned in *Acts 16:1-3* on **PAUL'S** second missionary journey to *Listra*. Regardless of when it was, **PAUL** considered the young **TIMOTHY** as his own "dearly beloved son" in the **FAITH**. 1 Timothy 1:2 – "Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith..." 2 Timothy 1:2 – "To Timothy, my dearly beloved son..."

No doubt the **APOSTLE PAUL** had a **GREAT IMPACT** upon this young man as he enlisted the young **TIMOTHY** to be one of his **FELLOW LABORERS! PAUL** took **TIMOTHY** under his wing and discipled him.

Under the LEADERSHIP of the APOSTLE PAUL, TIMOTHY was MOLDED into A GREAT SERVANT OF THE LORD and was very BENEFICIAL to the MINISTRY OF CHRIST and became a GREAT HELPER to PAUL, especially in his last days of MINISTRY.

So, what CHARACTERISTICS make for a SERVANT OF THE LORD?

I. BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES A SERVANT'S HEART. (2:19-24)

It is obvious that PAUL was concerned about the CHURCH at PHILIPPI. He wanted to send someone to both CONVEY HIS CONCERN and to ACCURATELY REPORT BACK to him on the WELFARE OF THE CHURCH.

PAUL was imprisoned in **ROME** at the time of writing this **EPISTLE.** There were certainly a great number of **BELIEVERS** in **ROME**. We know **PAUL** sent greetings to 26 of them by name in the last chapter of his book to the **ROMANS**.

Yet it appears that none of them were available to make this important trip for **PAUL**. They were so busy about their own lives that they had no time for this **IMPORTANT WORK OF THE LORD**. (Vs 20-21)

Sadly, this is one of the great and growing tragedies in most **CHURCHES** today also. It seems as though more and more we see that a great majority of **BELIEVERS**' time, energy and concern are diverted away from the things should matter the most to selfish, temporal interests.

Even though PAUL had no one else he could depend on, he knew that TIMOTHY CARED FOR PEOPLE and was CONCERNED ABOUT THEIR NEEDS. And PAUL'S desire was to send TIMOTHY to do what the APOSTLE PAUL could not do himself.

TIMOTHY had a GODLY CONCERN for the WELFARE OF OTHERS because he had a SERVANT'S HEART. TIMOTHY was not involved in promoting his own interests, rather, he was interested only in OTHERS, including the SPIRITUAL CONDITION OF GOD'S PEOPLE. How did this GODLY CONCERN develop? Well, that brings us to the next point.

BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES A SERVANT'S HEART...

II. BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES A SERVANT'S TRAINING.

The kind of **HEART** that **TIMOTHY** had was **NOT** a **NATURAL TRAIT!** By **NATURE** we are **PRONE TO BE SELFISH** and **LOOK OUT FOR NUMBER ONE!**

TIMOTHY became what he was because of the DILIGENT EFFORTS of other CHOICE SERVANTS OF THE LORD!

- A. There Was The TRAINING Under FAITHFUL FAMILY MEMBERS! (Grandmother And Mother) (2 Timothy 1:5; 3:14-15)
- B. There Was The TRAINING Under The APOSTLE PAUL. (Eph. 4:11-12; 2 Timothy 1:13; 2:1-2; 3:10, 14)
- C. There Was The TRAINING Under OTHERS IN THE CHURCH At LYSTRA. (Acts 14:6-7, 21-22; 16:1-2)

All of this TRAINING was BASED IN SCRIPTURE!

BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES A SERVANT'S HEART...REQUIRES A SERVANT'S TRAINING...

III. BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES THE ACTIONS OF A SERVANT. (2:25-30)

Just to call one a SERVANT OF THE LORD does not make them a SERVANT OF THE LORD!

To be a TRUE SERVANT OF THE LORD requires THE ACTIONS OF A SERVANT! We certainly see that in TIMOTHY!

Now let's look at PAUL'S mention of another SERVANT OF THE LORD who was such a one— EPAPHRODITUS.

PAUL was a "Hebrew of the Hebrews"—i.e. A full blooded Jew. TIMOTHY was part JEW and part GENTILE. EPAPHRODITUS was believed to be a full GENTILE whose GREEK name meant "charming." There is something "charming" about one who LIVES HIS FAITH! Amen!

EPAPHRODITUS was the member of the PHILIPPIAN CHURCH who had risked both his life and health to deliver their MISSIONARY OFFERING to PAUL in ROME and to HELP PAUL at ROME. (4:18)

- A. Note That He Was A BALANCED BELIEVER! (Vs 25)
 Notice PAUL'S three-fold description of him:
 - 1. "brother" He was SAVED by BELIEVING THE GOSPEL which made him a "BROTHER".
 - 2. "companion in labor"— He was SERVING with others for the furtherance of GOD and the GOSPEL!

- 3. "fellowsoldier"— He was a SOLDIER
 DEFENDING THE FAITH OF THE GOSPEL!
- B. Note That He Was A BURDENED BELIEVER!
 (Vs 25-27, 30)
 He, like TIMOTHY, SHOWED his CONCERN by his

ACTIONS!

- 1. He was BURDENED about PAUL. (Vs 25, 30)
 Volunteering to deliver the CHURCH'S love gift.
 He wasn't content just GIVING an offering.
 He GAVE HIMSELF to help carry the offering.
- 2. He was BURDENED about his CHURCH in PHILIPPI. (Vs 26-27)
 Because they were concerned about him.
- C. Note That He Was A BELOVED BELIEVER! (Vs 28-30)
 What a TRAGEDY it is to go through life and NOT BE A
 BLESSING to anyone!

EPAPHRODITUS was not that way! He was a **BLESSING TO PAUL** and he was a **BLESSING TO HIS CHURCH!**

PAUL exhorted the **CHURCH** at **PHILIPPI** to **HONOR** him because of his **SACRIFICE** and **SERVICE!**

Now we know that **CHRIST** is to get **ALL** the **GLORY** from whatever is accomplished through us. But, there is nothing wrong with **HONORING** those who **GLORIFY CHRIST** with their **LIFE** and **SERVICE!**

1 Thessalonians 5:12-13—"And we beseech you, brethren, to

know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; 13 And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake."

EPAPHRODITUS had **SACRIFICED** himself with no thought of reward, but **PAUL** encouraged the **CHURCH** to **HONOR** him.

Conclusion

We've seen here in PHILIPPIANS three GREAT SERVANTS OF THE LORD—THE APOSTLE PAUL, TIMOTHY, and EPAPHRODITUS. All three of these men were cut out of the same PATTERN that we are to FOLLOW—THE PATTERN OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST!

Their lives were **INFLUENCED** by others who came before them so that they became a **GREAT INFLUENCE** in the lives of even more!

Do you have what it takes to be such an **INFLUENTIAL SERVANT** yourself? *BEING A SERVANT OF THE LORD REQUIRES A SERVANT'S HEART...REQUIRES A SERVANT'S TRAINING...REQUIRES THE ACTIONS OF A SERVANT.* A SERVANT SERVES!

It begins with **SALVATION.** Only as we **SUBMIT** to the **LORD JESUS CHRIST** can we have and develop a **SERVANT'S HEART!**

Only as we allow HIS WORD, HIS HOLY SPIRIT, and HIS SERVANTS to TEACH us can we gain the required training to become a PROPER SERVANT OF THE LORD!

And only as the **LORD JESUS CHRIST** lives **HIS LIFE** through our lives will our lives show the **ACTIONS** of a **PROPER SERVANT OF THE LORD!** Are you putting into practice what you know?
