Discussion Questions

- 1. Read the parallel triumphal entry passages (Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; John 12:12-19). How do those passages enhance our understanding of what happened that day? Why might each author have included or excluded certain details?
- 2. What details in Luke 19:28-40 point to Jesus as the divine Messiah?
- 3. What does this passage tell us about Jesus' relationship with the disciples? What lesson is there for us?
- 4. What is it about the people's celebration that points to why they called for his death a few days later?
- 5. How expectations might we sometimes have of God that can lead to disappointment and sinful attitudes?
- 6. What does Jesus' response to the Pharisees communicate to them (see Habakkuk 2:11)?
- 7. How does the triumphal entry compare with the future return of Christ? How will the future entry to Jerusalem be different?
- 8. What implications for our lives can we draw from this passage?
