Matters that make marriage marvelous:

- Be particular (verses 1-8)
 - o Discover their **faith** (2 Corinthians 6:14-18)
 - o Consider their **family** (22-24)
 - Consult with your <u>parents</u>
 - Be considerate of **their parents** (verses 34-50)
 - o Observe their **personality** (verse 16-20)
- Be **prayerful** (verses 11-15)
 - o Pray about your mate
 - o Pray **for** your mate
 - o Pray with your mate
 - 1 Peter 3:7 Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.
- Be <u>pure</u> (verse 16)
 - O Abstain before marriage
 - 1 Corinthians 6:18 Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body.
 - o Maintain romance in marriage
 - Proverbs 5:15-20 (Do not display)
 - Genesis 26:8 (do not display)
 - o **Remain** pure in marriage
 - Proverbs 6:32-33 Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding; He who does so destroys his own soul. ³³ Wounds and dishonor he will get, And his reproach will not be wiped away.
 - Hebrews 13:4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.
- Be <u>purified</u> 1 Corinthians 6:6-9 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹And such <u>were</u> some of you. But you were <u>washed</u>, but you were <u>sanctified</u>, but you were <u>justified</u> in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.
