1. False teachers hinder the work of The Truth. 5:7

Acts 20:24 “But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God.

2 Timothy 4:7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith;

2. False teachers are never from God. 5:8

Jeremiah 23:16,22–21

There are only two sources of knowledge: God or Satan

God is the father of lights and the giver of every good thing and every perfect gift and He never varies from this.

Satan is the father of lies and when he speaks he speaks a lie because he is by nature a liar.

3. False teachers are lethal to the church. 5:9
