Four imperatives followed by an exhortation to the father's discipline (vv.11,12)

I. A Hymn to Wisdom (3:13-18)

- God desires our happiness our happiness is bound up with our creator
 - A. The value of wisdom to man (Adam) (vv.13-18)
 - i. Better than Treasure, No Human Desires Compares to Her (14,15)
 - ii. Queen Wisdom Gives the Length of Days & Riches & Honor (16,17)
 - iii. She is a Tree of Life to All Who Take Hold of Her (v.18)
 - B. The value of wisdom to God (vv 19-20)
 - i. The Lord by wisdom founded the earth & established the heavens
 - ii. The Lord by knowledge broke upon the deep & waters from the skies

II. The Application of Wisdom (3:20-35)

- A. The value of wisdom to the Son (21-27)
 - i. First Admonition: "Guard wisdom with your life" (vv.21-24)
 - ii. Second Admonition: "Don't fear disaster" (vv. 25,26)
- B. Wisdom's implications & application: love your neighbor (vv 28-35)
 - i. Repay your needy neighbor (vv. 27–28)
 - ii. Do not harm your innocent neighbor (vv. 29–30)
 - iii. Do not envy your wicked neighbor (vv. 31–35)
