

# REVELATION 28 – PHILADELPHIA: STEWARDSHIP HONORED

Dr. Leon L. Sanders Revelation 3:8-10

### STEWARDSHIP: RESTING IN THE AUTHORITY

- Steward has no intrinsic authority, dependent on extrinsic authority who delegates the position; Christ knows their, your, works (Jn 5:19-24, 30-36)
  - Philadelphia has no intrinsic power; power intrinsic only to the Father (Ge 1:1-2; Ps 50:10-12)
- Christ holds open door to Father because of His loyalty AEB their: (ICo 4:2)
  - Keeping Christ's Word; entire Bible (Jn 1:1-5; 17:14-17)
  - Identifying with Christ's name, Gospel message (Ac 4:12)
- Resting in Christ, maturation: we decrease, <u>He</u> increases (Mt 11:25-30; Jn 3:27-36)
  - Christ demonstrated humility as prophesized giving us His example to follow (Is 9:6-7; 53; Ph 2:3-11)

## FALSE JEWS – POOR STEWARDS: COVETED SELF STRENGTH – CONTROL

- As a people, Hebrews-Jews were poor stewards though smallest of all (De 7:6-8)
  - Sinners worship self strength, despising God's weakness: Cain-Abel (Ge 4:1-8)
  - Jews <u>chose</u> self strength, kingship, over *resting* in God's protection; i.e., so they could do what was right in their own eyes {Satan's Promise of Sin}: Control (Ge 3:5; Ju 21:25; ISa 8:19-22; )
  - When Elijah trusted *his* strength, he feared Jezebel's Control, death threat; learned God works through *still small voice*, not miraculous power {Mount Horeb} (IKi 19:1-18)
  - Jews of Christ's time honored their fathers who murdered God's prophets showing they worshipped self strength; hence, they rejected *meek-weak* Messiah (Lk 11:47-51)
  - Thus, Messiah rejects them until they repent, repentance precedes forgiveness Always; then they follow weak Messiah, Jesus (Am 8:11-12; Ze 12:10; Lk 13:34-35)

### SYNAGOGUE OF SATAN: ONLY TRUE JEWS ARE JEWS

- Since Jews rejected Messiah, He sent Gospel to the Gentiles until the time of their calling and repentance (Is 42:6-7; Ez 36:19-21; Mt 4:14-16; Ro 11:25-31; Re 7:9-17; 12:13-14)
  - God rejects automatic salvation based on birth or group membership; Jew is one who believes God following Abraham's example (Ro 2:17-29; 4:1-5, 10-12; Ga 4:21-31; He 11:8-12; Ja 2:21-26)
  - Jews who reject Messiah are **not** *True* Jews; *False* Jews, antichrists (Jn 8:21-30; IJo 2:18, 22-23; 4:2-3; 2Jo 7-11)
  - Jesus calls them: Synagogue of Satan as they follow their father, Satan (Jn 8:44)
- False Jews will acknowledge Christ at White Throne judgment (Re 20:11-15)
  - They will acknowledge Christ as Lord as they acknowledge His faithful stewards, Saved, whom they reject and persecute; as will <u>All</u> Sinners (Ph 2:9-11)

#### TIME OF TROUBLE APPROACHES: ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPENTANCE

- This is first reference to: Time of (Jacob's) Trouble or Great Tribulation (Je 30:5-9)
  - Faithful Philadelphia, metaphor of <u>all</u> faithful churches, will be kept from this trial {Rapture} because of Christ's faithful loyalty to the Saved (ICo 15:50-58; ITh 4:15-18)
  - Christ's call that brings churches <u>out</u> of the World, regathers *True* Jews from <u>all</u> nations fulfilling His promises to *True* Jews; they take Gospel to the World
    (Ps 118: ls 11:11-12; Hos 3; Amos 9:7-12; Re 7:1-8)
  - True Jews shall repent, acknowledging their sin <u>and</u> the sins of their fathers, accepting Christ as Messiah (Je 50:4-5; Ze 12:10)
  - In that Day, and into Millennial Kingdom, Jews will be what Christ intended them to be from their first calling: His {Non-Aaronic} Priests to the nations (Ex 19:5; Is 61:6; He 7)

### STEWARDS ARE TO BE FAITHFUL: NOT SUCCESSFUL

- Christ is <u>not</u> looking for successful people to conquer the Devil; He is the Father's Steward and already has this victory (Lk 10:17-20; Re 20:10)
- Christ is developing a people who, like the Philadelphians, are **faithful-loyal**:
  - Keep His Word (Jn 8:31-47)
  - Identify themselves with His Name; do not deny Him or the Father (Mt 10:32-33)
- By the World's standards we are weak and foolish (ICo I:18-31)
  - But through Christ-Word-Spirit we mature, using able to discern <u>Father's</u> Good and reject <u>our</u> Evil: Discernment (Ge 5:21-24; Jn 1:1-5, 9-11; 8:12; ICo 2:14; He 5:11-14)
  - If we measure ourselves by World's standards, we are not wise: Are You Wise? (Ro 2:1-11; 2Co 10:12, 17-18)
