BOOK OF ZECHARIAH THE VISION OF THE FOUR CHARIOTS THE WRATH OF GOD ZECHARIAH 6:1-8

Introduction

We've seen how ZECHARIAH'S first five VISIONS were encouraging ones of HOPE for the FUTURE in the MESSIANIC KINGDOM.

The sixth, seventh, and eighth VISIONS concern the JUDGMENTS that will come upon ISRAEL as well as the rest of the world before MESSIAH returns in GLORY to REIGN in JERUSALEM!

In Chapter 5 we saw 6th VISION... THE VISION OF THE FLYING ROLL (SCROLL) and 7TH VISION... THE VISION OF THE EPHAH relating to the SINS OF THE NATIONS..

Now in **Chapter 6** we see the eighth and last night **VISION** that **ZECHARIAH** tells us about. Let's read the verses relating to this eighth **VISION**.

WE SEE THE APOCALYPTIC JUDGMENT OF THE ENDTIMES. (*Zechariah 6:1-8*)

We see here that **APOCALYPTIC JUDGMENT** is **GOD'S RESPONSE** to the **INCREASING UNGODLINESS** found in **ECONOMICS**, **POLITICS**, and **RELIGION** and the alignment of the NATIONS against and mistreatment of GOD'S CHOSEN PEOPLE ISRAEL.

There are FOUR CHARIOTS mentioned in *Vs 1-3* that are carrying DIFFERENT COLORED HORSES.

In *Vs.* **5** we are told that these FOUR CHARIOTS are FOUR SPIRITS OF THE HEAVENS that have come forth from STANDING BEFORE THE LORD! Which leads us to surmise that they are some of the LORD'S ANGELS who have been sent by HIM to POUR OUT HIS JUDGMENT on the WORLD—esp. ISRAEL'S ADVERSARIES.

The number FOUR is the number associated with CREATION and marks GOD'S CREATIVE WORKS. It is a signature of the WORLD. There were FOUR DIVINE ACTS on the first day of CREATION. (GOD SAID, GOD SAW, GOD DIVIDED, GOD CALLED–Gen. 1:5)

FOUR regions: North, South, East, West FOUR elements: Earth, Air, Fire, Water FOUR seasons: Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter FOUR kingdoms: mineral, plant, animal, spiritual FOUR divisions of our day: morning, noon, evening, night

FOUR GREAT WORLD POWERS were revealed to the PROPHET DANIEL! (BABYLON, MEDO-PERSIA, GREECE, ROME!)

We'll see more about this when we get to BIBLICAL NUMEROLOGY in our midweek BIBLE STUDY on BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION!

Now, both **CHARIOTS** and **HORSES** are often mentioned in the **BIBLE** in connection with **POWER**, **WAR**, and **JUDGMENT** (Cp. *Revelation 6, Jeremiah 46:9-10, Joel 2:3-11 and Nahum 3:1-7*).

Our LORD'S return is described in *Revelation 19*, where it is prophesied that HE will come for JUDGMENT with HIS HEAVENLY ARMIES on HORSES to establish HIS KINGDOM! (*Revelation 19:11-16*)

These ANGELS OF JUDGMENT written about here in *Zechariah 6* came from before the LORD and between TWO MOUNTAINS (*verse 1*) which are believed to refer to MOUNT MORIAH and the MOUNT OF OLIVES because they are directly connected with CHRIST'S RETURN. The VALLEY OF JEHOSHAPHAT lies between the TWO MOUNTAINS, which is also mentioned often in SCRIPTURE in connection with the LORD'S JUDGMENT upon the NATIONS.

Joel 3:1–2–1 For, behold, in those days, and in that time, When I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem, 2 I will also gather all nations, And will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, And will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, Whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land. (Jehoshaphat means "Jehovah Judges" (a/k/a "the valley of decision")

The two mountains are described as **BRASS**, referring to a **STRENGTH** and **STABILITY** which nothing can shake (it also refers to **JUDGMENT**): *Isaiah 2:2–"And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the Lord's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it"*

The **CHARIOTS** go off for **JUDGMENT** in three separate directions:

- The BLACK and WHITE HORSES go NORTH (verse 6).
 (Rome, Assyria, Babylon always attacked Israel from the North. In the North is also Gog and Magog)
 BLACK is indicative of CALAMITY and DEATH!
 WHITE is indicative of VICTORY and JOY!
 - The GRISLED (SPOTTED) HORSES go SOUTH (verse 6) GRISLED is indicative of PLAGUES and PESTILENCE (Egypt)
- The **BAY HORSES** (meaning **STRONG COLORED** or **RED**) go all over the earth *(verse 7)*.
 - **RED** is indicative of **WAR** and **BLOODSHED**.

These are not limited to going in one direction as they were to walk to and fro through the earth!.

Each of these went forth to accomplish GOD'S WILL in JUDGMENT!

This picture fits the description of the JUDGMENTS ON THE NATIONS in the TRIBULATION PERIOD.

According to *Daniel 11:40* and following, the kings of the **NORTH** and **SOUTH** will arise to wage war against **ISRAEL**.

Again, the **NORTH** is believed to refer to **BABYLON** (**IRAQ**), which has always attacked **ISRAEL** from that direction. It also refers to **ASSYRIA** (**SYRIA**), which lies north of **ISRAEL**. If we extend the definition of "NORTH" a little farther, it stands for the power of **GOG** from the land of **MAGOG** in the far **NORTH**. *Ezekiel 38 and 39* explain that **GOD** will destroy this power.

Micah 5:6 also says: "And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver us from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders."

The king of the **SOUTH** (**EGYPT**) will be overcome and judged by the **LORD**. *Zechariah 10:11*: "...And the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the scepter of Egypt shall depart away."

According to the book of **REVELATION**, the **APOCALYPTIC JUDGMENTS** will come upon the entire world which is indicated in *vs 7*. But only when the **CHARIOTS** go to the **NORTH COUNTRY** does the **ANGEL'S SPIRIT** find rest *(verse 8)*. Why? Because **GOD'S JUDGMENT** upon the **NATIONS** will end, and the **LORD** will return.

Therefore, the **NORTH COUNTRY** includes *"BABYLON,"* which was the basis for a world-ruling power, the godless collaboration of the **NATIONS** in rebellion against **GOD** (the **TOWER OF BABEL**).

NIMROD was the founder of **BABYLON** *(Genesis 10:8-10)* and the first despot on earth. However, all the ungodly powers and the power of the last

despot on earth will ultimately be united under the term "BABYLON" *(Revelation 17-18).*

ISRAEL was always attacked from the **NORTH** by her enemies, even by the **ROMANS.** Therefore, *verse 8* can be seen as a summary which says that **JUDGMENT** over all enemy nations opposing **ISRAEL** and the **ANOINTED** (*Psalm 2*) have reached their ultimate fulfillment.

Subsequently, the **ANGEL'S SPIRIT** has been quieted because the **LORD'S** jealousy for **HIS PEOPLE** will have been quieted. Remember how the **LORD** said in *Zechariah 1:14-15* : "I am jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great jealousy. And I am very sore displeased with the heathen that are at ease."

The LORD will appear in HIS GLORY now that JUDGMENT has been fulfilled and the LORD'S SPIRIT and JEALOUSY have been quieted. ISRAEL will be led to REST in the KINGDOM of her MESSIAH JESUS.

Hebrews 4:9–"There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God"

The NATIONS will also enter into HIS REST:

Isaiah 11:10– "And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious"

Practically all of **GOD'S** endtime **JUDGMENTS** on earth are mentioned in *Zechariah 5:1—6:8:*

- the judgment upon the people of the end-times;
- the judgment upon end-time Babylon;
- the judgment upon the enemies from the north of Israel;
- the judgment upon the south; and
- the judgment upon the entire earth.

But, whoever believes on **CHRIST** and gives his life to **HIM** will not come into **JUDGMENT!** The **LORD** said this in *John 5:24:*

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation (or judgment); but is passed from death unto life."
