## Different Behavior Pt. 2

Ephesians 4:28-32

- **I. STUFF** (28)—from stealing to sharing
  - **A.** <u>Private Property Is Biblical</u>. (Ex 20:15, 17; Deut 8:17-18; 1 Sam 2:7; Jud 11:24; Ecc 5:19 & 6:2; 1 Chr 29:12)
  - B. Stop Stealing.—

By force or by fraud...

- 1. It is selfish. (Mat 7:12 & 22:39)—failure to love neighbor as self
  - **a.** <u>laziness</u>—(1 Thes 5:14; 2 Thes 3:11)
  - b. covetousness
- **2.** It is godless. (Ps 115:4; 135:15; Jer 2:27-28)—does not trust God, is *idolatrous* 
  - **a.** <u>Distrusts</u> God's ability to <u>provide</u>. (Ps 25:1-3; 52:7; Pro 6:30-31; Isa 57:11; Mat 6:11, 25-34)—does't factor God in
  - **b.** <u>Discontent</u> with God's provision. (2 Sam 12:8-9; 1 Tim 3:8 & 6:6-10; 1 Pet 5:2)—

## C. Instead Start:

- 1. Working (Gen 2:15; 1 Thes 4:11-12; 2 Thes 3:6-12; )
  - a. Work is a good thing. (Gen 2:15)—created for this
  - **b. Idleness promotes vice.** (2 Thes 3:11)
  - c. Manual labor is not demeaning! (2 Thes 3:7-8)
  - d. Christian work must be honest labor.
- 2. **Sharing** (Act 20:35; 2 Cor 8:9 & 9:7; 1 Tim 6:17-18)
  - a. Personal Responsibility for charity
  - b. Personal Desire to help others
  - c. New Attitude toward God and neighbor
- 3. **Example** of Christ (Eph 4:8; 2 Cor 8:9; )
- II. <u>SPEECH</u> (29-31; Mat 12:34; 15:11, 18; Lk 6:45)—Harmful to Helpful
  - A. <u>Ungodly Talk</u> ()—corrupt, unwholesome—*rotten trees or fruit* 
    - 1. <u>Destructive</u> (Ps 15:3; Prov 10:6-7; 12:18; Rom 3:13-14; Jam 3:8-12)
      - **a.** <u>Clamor</u>—loud uproar, yelling, screaming in rage, violent threats
      - b. <u>Slander</u>—(Ps 15:3) ranting, badmouthing, abusive criticism
    - 2. Inappropriate (Eph 5:4)
      - **a. Obscenity** (Eph 5:4; Mat 5:28; Rom 12:10a)
      - **b. Disrespect** (Rom 12:10b & 13:7; )
      - **c. Grumbling** (Eph 5:4b; Num 14:27; 1 Cor 10:8-11; Phil 2:14-15)

- **3. Grieves the Holy Spirit** (30; Gen 6:3; Ps 66:18;)
  - a. The Holy Spirit is a Person, not some impersonal force.
  - **b.** Disunity is the work of the Devil. (Gal 5:19-24)
  - c. Don't work against the Holy Spirit. (Ps 51:11; 1 Cor 3:17)
- **B.** <u>Christian Speech</u> (Eph 4:15, 25; Isa 50:4; Col 4:6)—
  - 1. Builds Up (1 Cor 8:1; 10:23; 13:1-5; 14:12)—constructive, beneficial, edifying
    - a. Motivated by love, not pride
    - b. Focused on the other, not self
    - c. Helps the other rise and advance
  - **2.** Fits the Occassion (Col 4:5-6; 1 Tim 5:1-2; 1 Pet 3:15; )
    - a. Consider the relationship.—age, sex, believer or unbeliever
    - b. Consider the <u>person</u>.—their background, beliefs, feelings
    - c. Consider the time and place. (Ecc 3:1-8)
    - d. Be gracious.—respectful, kind, considerate
  - 3. Gives Grace ()—benefits, helps
- **III. DISPOSITION** (31-32)—temperament, character, inclination toward others
  - A. <u>Ungodly Disposition</u> (31)—In keeping with the old, sinful nature
    - 1. <u>Unresolved Anger</u>—characteristic of the unregenerate nature
      - a. Bitterness—inward resentment
      - b. Wrath—vindictive, relentless, unforgiving; blind rage
      - c. Anger—strong annoyance or displeasure resulting in hostility
    - 2. <u>Verbal Attacks</u>—venting sinful anger, going scorched-earth
    - **3.** <u>Malice</u> ()—rooted anger that prompts a person to plot and commit harm to someone; *anger hardened into hatred*
  - B. <u>Christian Disposition</u> (32)— love for neighbor
    - 1. **Kind**—considerate, friendly; motivated by love for others
    - 2. Tender hearted—able to feel sympathy, pity or compassion
    - 3. Forgiving—merciful, willing to forgive
    - 4. Christlike—as Jesus taught and modeled by example
      - a. Jesus' teaching (Mat 6:12, 14-15; 18:22, 35; Mk 11:25; Lk 17:3-4; ).
      - b. Jesus' example (Lk 23:34; 1 Pet 2:23).
    - **5. Self-aware** (Mat 18:32-33; Lk 7:41-47)—how much we have been forgiven!
