A NEW MINDSET

Ephesians 4:17-24

- **I. AUTHORITATIVE DOCTRINE** (17; Jude 1:3)
 - A. Apostolic Authority— establishing official Christian doctrine
 - 1. Writing with the authority of Jesus
 - 2. In keeping with the teaching and Spirit of Jesus
 - B. <u>Insistent Tone</u>—adamant, unrelenting, no option to refuse
 - **C.** <u>Official Command</u>—You Must Not live/behave *like the Gentiles!* Purity just as important as unity
- II. THE OLD NATURE (18, 19, 22)—sinful nature we are born with, in Adam
 - A. <u>Benchmarks of Decline</u> (Rom 1:18-32)—a picture of self-destruction
 - 1. Hardened Heart (Obstinate, stubborn)—
 - **2. Darkened Mind** (Jn 3:19-20; 2 Thes 2:9-12; 1 Tim 4:2)—Futile minds, ignorant, calloused
 - **3. Deadened Soul** (Rom 6:21, 23)—Alienated from the life of God, incurring judgment)
 - 4. Reckless Life—loss of self-control, increasingly depraved sexuality
 - B. Sexual Impurity—particularly characteristic of heathen idol worship
- III. <u>THE NEW NATURE</u> (20, 21, 23, 24)—born again in Christ, new creation Recreated in God's Image, fresh, beautiful, full of life
 - A. Marks of New Life
 - **1. Softened Heart** (Ezek 11:19; 36:26; Jer 31:33)—Heart of stone removed, sensitivity to the Holy Spirit restored
 - **2. Enlightened Mind** (Ps 119:130; Mat 11:25; Jn 14:26; 1 Cor 2:9)—given understanding by the Holy Spirit
 - **3. Enlivened Soul** (Jn 3:36 & Jn10:10; Rom 8:6, 11; Gal 6:8; 1 Jn 5:11)—reconciled to God; new, abundant life in Christ

- **4. Godly Life** (v. 24; Lk 1:74-75)—righteous & holy
- B. <u>Sexual Purity</u>
- IV. <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> (20-24;)—growing in righteousness and holiness
 - A. Personal Effort is Required (22, 24)—active, not passive
 - **1. Sanctification is the fruit of salvation** (Eph 2:8-10)
 - **2. We must <u>actively pursue</u> holiness** (Phil 2:12-13 & 3:13-14; 1 Tim 4:7-8)
 - B. <u>Metaphor of Clothing</u> (22, 24)—picture of repentance & transformation
 - 1. You are a new person ()—new creation; new identity, status, job
 - 2. Change your clothes (1 Jn 3:5-6)—dress in keeping with new life
 - C. Renewal of Your Mind (20-24)—moral education and transformation—
 - 1. <u>Importance of the Mind</u> (Rom 12:1-2)—Christianity is not mindless!
 - 2. Importance of Teaching (Mat 28:19-20)—Christ Centered
 - a. Learned Christ—You were taught the Christian faith (all about Him)
 - **b.** <u>Heard *Him*</u>—hearing **His voice** through their Christian teachers, having **His Spirit** enlightening
 - **c.** <u>Taught in Him</u>—Christ is the context
 - **d.** The Truth as it is in Jesus (Jn 14:6; Ps 29:2; 1 Jn 3:2-3)—the truth of the gospel
 - 3. <u>The Changing of Desires</u> (22; Ezek 11:19-21; Rom 6:17-19)
 - a. Feed the renewed mind.—truth from the scriptures
 - b. Cultivate holy, healthy desires.
 - c. Surround yourself with likeminded Christians—fellowship, accountability, support
