**Theme:** The people of God will experience persecution and opposition. We can stand with confidence if it is the "message" that is opposed. When challenged – will we defend ourselves, or the gospel??

**Background/Introduction:** Who confesses to a crime of which they have not been accused?

- 1. Festus needs help! The Appeal (Festus to Agrippa)
  - Help me figure out what to say Agrippa.
  - Not reasonable to send him without saying something about the nature of the "offense".
- 2. Christianity isn't religion of rebellion

Paul's Defense - Part 1

## I. Establishing the Case

- A. Standing before Agrippa II
- B. The accusations against him?
  - 1. Charges of the Jews?
    - Nothing deserving death. (25:25)
    - Assertions about a dead man that Paul says is alive (25:19)
  - 2. From Paul The charge is against his HOPE.
    - a. His *hope* is in the promises of God (vv.6,7)
    - b. His and their hope in the resurrection. (v.8)
      (Job 19:25; Ps. 19:6; P)s. 17: 15; Ps. 49:15; Is. 25:8;
      Is. 26:19; Dan. 12:2; Dan. 12:13; Hos. 13:14)
      Zechariah had given voice to that hope Luke 1:68ff
    - c. His *hope* is in the resurrection of particular individual. (V.9)

## **II.** Answering the Charges

- A. Jews?
  - He is a Pharisee.
  - He is no traitor!
- B. From Paul
  - a. Paul makes the case against himself. (26:9-11)
    - Not being tried for what he did,
    - But for what he stopped doing!
  - b. He was/is one of them.
    - like them, he didn't believe
    - like them, persecuted those of "The Way"

## III. Making his Defense

- A. Not defending himself but the gospel!
- B. He is on the offense
  - 1. On trial for the hope of the resurrection.
  - 2. Why won't you believe?

## IV. Our Only Defense - Application

- 1. What hope do we have of defending ourselves before the throne of God? None! apart from Him who died and rose again.
- 2. Our defense is not *just* about avoiding punishment or death. It is about upholding the glory and honor of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. At the heart to the gospel we preach is the resurrection of Jesus the 1<sup>st</sup> fruits of those who have fallen asleep.
