Amos 9:11-15

"In that day I will raise up  
the booth of David that is fallen  
and repair its breaches,  
and raise up its ruins  
and rebuild it as in the days of old,  
<sup>12</sup> that they may possess the remnant of Edom  
and all the nations who are called by my name,"  
declares the LORD who does this.  
<sup>13</sup> "Behold, the days are coming," declares the LORD,  
"when the plowman shall overtake the reaper  
and the treader of grapes him who sows the seed;  
the mountains shall drip sweet wine,  
and all the hills shall flow with it.  
<sup>14</sup> I will restore the fortunes of my people Israel,  
and they shall rebuild the ruined cities and inhabit them;  
they shall plant vineyards and drink their wine,  
and they shall make gardens and eat their fruit.  
<sup>15</sup> I will plant them on their land,  
and they shall never again be uprooted  
out of the land that I have given them,"  
says the LORD your God.

5 Anchors of Hope for the Faithful in Hard Times

1. We will have a glorious king (v.11)
  - a. This is a clear physical reality of our current spiritual reality
  - b. What actions does he say he will do? I will raise up, I will repair, I will raise up, I will rebuild
  - c. You cannot live in sin and say you have a savior, you cannot excuse injustice and unrighteousness and say you have Jesus.
2. We will be a united people (v.12)
3. We will live in a fruitful land (v.13)
4. We will be a satisfied people (v.14)

- a. Verse 13 paints a picture of abundance, and verse 14 shows the people of God thoroughly enjoying that abundance
- 5. We will be a secure people (v.15)
