- A. The Bible clearly shows that it is the Word of God by its majesty¹ and purity,² by the agreement of all its parts, by its unified aim to give all glory to God,⁴ and by its illuminating power to convince and convert sinners, and to comfort and build up believers unto salvation.5 However, only the Spirit of God, testifying by and with the Bible in our hearts, can completely persuade us that it is truly the Word of God.⁶
