WIVES AND HUSBANDS

Ephesians 5:21-33

- 1. All of the general commands for *all* Christians *still apply within marriage*.
- 2. Any Christian teaching on authority must refer to Jesus' teaching and example. (Mat 20:25-28)
- 3. The Christian doctrine of marriage is not a magic formula for personal fulfillment.
- I. Submitting to One Another (15, 17, 21)
 - A. Every Christian is called to submit himself/herself:
 - 1. For a greater good
 - 2. Uniquely in particular relationships

B. <u>Christian submission is motivated by the two great commandments</u> (Mat 22:37-40)—love for God and neighbor.

- 2. <u>Reverence for Christ</u>—commitment to something bigger
- II. <u>The Calling of Wife</u> (22-24; Gen 2:18)—suitable helper (ezer) for the man
 - A. <u>Submit to Husband</u> ()—supportive strength, arranged under
 - 1. <u>Devoted Strength</u> (Prov 14:1 & 31:10-12)—does not imply inferior strength or worth
 - Not Absolute Obedience (21,22; Acts 4:19)—ultimate loyalty belongs to Christ

 a. Do not obey him if he tells you to sin.
 - b. Do not enable his sin.

c. Do not be a <u>passive doormat</u>. Submission does not mean tolerating chronic abuse.

3. Not to All Men—to your man, your individual husband

B. <u>**Respect Husband**</u> (Eph 4:25-32; 1 Pet 3:9)—Not competing, undermining, henpecking, putting him down, insulting, manipulating...

- 1. Basic respect due to every human
- 2. <u>Specific respect for position</u> of responsibility
- 3. Especially demonstrated in the way we speak to him and about him

III. The Calling of Husband (25-31)—

- A. Love His Wife (25, 28-30)—
 - 1. As He Loves His Own Body (28-30; Mat 22:39)—as much as he cares for himself

2. As <u>Christ Loved the Church</u> (25; Jn 13:34 &15:12-13)—prioritizes her, sacrifices himself for her good

- B. Take Responsibility (26, 31)—Authority granted to serve others, not self
 - 1. For the <u>Well-being of His Wife</u> ()
 - a. To Make Her Holy
 - b. To Make Her <u>Beautiful</u>
 - 2. For the Leadership of His Family (Gen 2:24; Mat 19:5)
 - a. Leave His Parents—He initiates a new relationship
 - b. <u>Hold Fast to His Wife</u>—intentional, on-going devotion; prioritizes her
 - c. <u>Become One Flesh</u> ()—not just you anymore; intimate partnership
- **IV.** <u>The Ultimate Relationship</u> (32)—marriage pictures Christ and the Church
 - A. Don't Idolize Marriage.
 - 1. Marriage is a picture of something greater.
 - 2. Marriage is temporary, not eternal. (Mat 22:30)
 - 3. Your husband is not Jesus.
 - B. Honor Jesus in Your Marriage. Ultimately it is He who will judge and reward.
 - 1. Put Jesus first. (Mat 10:37-38; 1 Cor 7:15)
 - 2. Love the way Jesus loves you. (Jn 13:35; 15:12)
 - 3. Serve as Jesus serves. (Mat 20:28; Jn 13:14)
