REVIEW

- The goal of the Christian is to "stand" = to persevere in your faith.
- The enemy of the Christian is powerful.
 - PrincePowerful
 - Rulers of darkness
 - Hosts of spiritual wickedness

REVIEW

- Our METHOD is to take up the provided armor.
- Our MOTIVE is that we may be able to stand (only God's armor will work); and to stand (God's armor will work, if used).
- Our DOCTRINE: These pieces of armor have reference to Christ.
 - Perseverance rests on believing in Christ's sufficiency
 - Perseverance rests on being assured of Christ's work

Q2: WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A SUBJECTIVE VIEW OF THE ARMOR AND AN OBJECTIVE VIEW?

1. THE BELT OF TRUTH

- Truth holds up everything else
- "Should we be surprised when...?"
- Truth without application?

2. THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Our primary protection against Satan's attack
 - Q: What do we mean by "righteousness"?

• Q: What doctrines / truths supports this idea?

• Q: What, then, is our tendency when we sin?

3. "HAVING <u>SHOD</u> YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- "Shod"?-
 - Middle English, past participle of "shoe"
 - · Acts 12:8 "... tie on your sandals...."
 - · Slip-shod? Dry-shod?

3. "HAVING SHOD YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- Normal Roman soldier footwear
- "Preparation" = readiness; or stability (in the sense of a well-prepared base or foundation).

3. "HAVING SHOD YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- SCRIPTURES (related to God/gospel): Acts
 10:36; Romans 5:1; Romans 10:15; Romans
 15:13; Colossians 1:20
- Q: Are you at peace with God? Is God at peace with you? Do we remember this when tempted to quit?
