Abram's GOOD CHOICE & Lot's BAD CHOICE

Genesis 13:1-18

Introduction: v.1-7 – Pressures and Difficulties often force us to make important decisions:

I. Abram's GOOD CHOICE (v.8-9; 14-18)



- A. Abram chose to stay <u>cool</u> & <u>calm</u> and did not make a hasty move (v.8)
- B. Abram chose to <u>graciously</u> & <u>unselfishly</u> offer Lot the land he preferred (v.9)
- C. Abram chose to trust God with the result of the decision
- D. Abram's choice resulted in him receiving God's very best (v.14-18)

II. Lot's BAD CHOICE (v.10-13)



- A. Lot chose based on what he <u>saw</u> with his <u>eyes</u> (v.10a)
- B. Lot chose based on the prospect of <u>material advantage</u> (Monetary gain)(v.10b)
- C. Lot chose out of <u>selfish motives</u>, seeking the best <u>for himself</u>.(v.11)
- D. Lot's choice made him vulnerable to making <u>other bad choices</u>. (v.12-13)
- E. Lot's choice negatively affected not only himself, but his entire family (Compare: Genesis 19:14-17; 26; 35-38)
