“Yahweh is God”

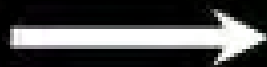
Joel uses the description of a plague of Locusts and a drought to call the people to repentance with fear , fasting and prayer.

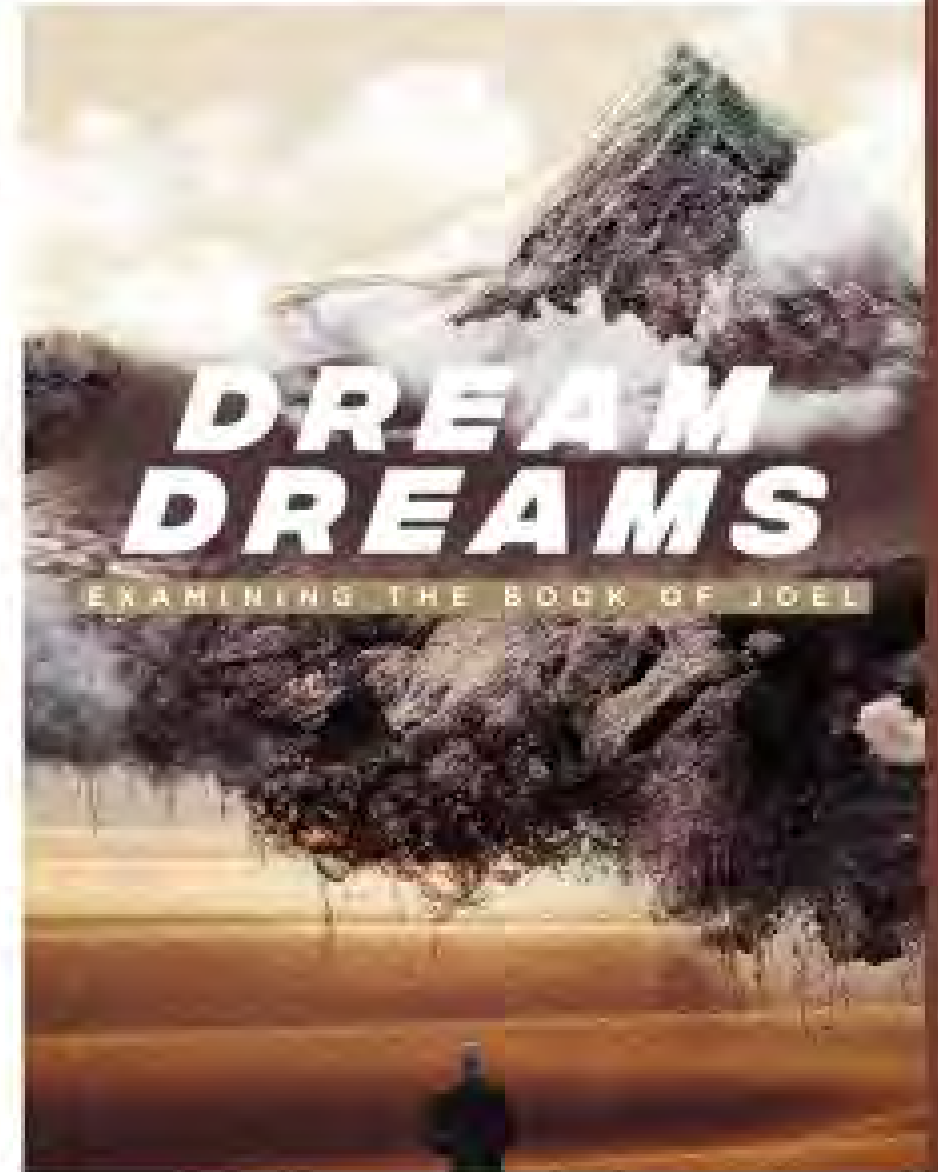


## Joel 3:1 (TEV)

<sup>1</sup> The LORD says, "At that **time** I will restore the prosperity of Judah and Jerusalem.

## Joel 3:1 (KJV)

<sup>1</sup> For, behold, in those days, and in that **time**, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem,



## **Joel 3:2 (TEV)**

<sup>2</sup> I will gather all the nations and bring them to the Valley of Judgment. There I will judge them for all they have done to my people. They have scattered the Israelites in foreign countries and divided Israel, my land.

## **Joel 3:2 (KJV)**

<sup>2</sup> I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.



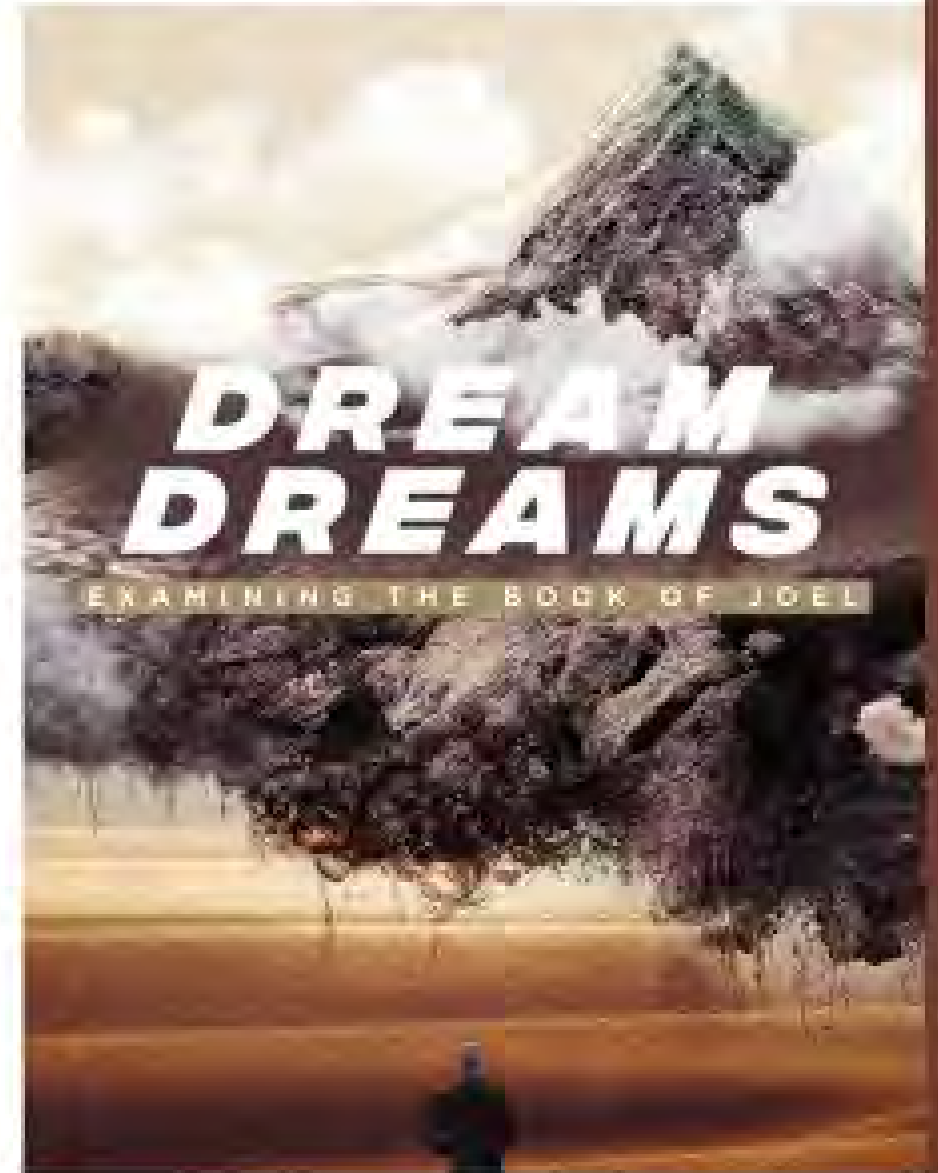


## **Joel 3:3 (TEV)**

<sup>3</sup> They threw dice to decide who would get the captives. They sold boys and girls into slavery to pay for prostitutes and wine.

## **Joel 3:3 (KJV)**

<sup>3</sup> And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

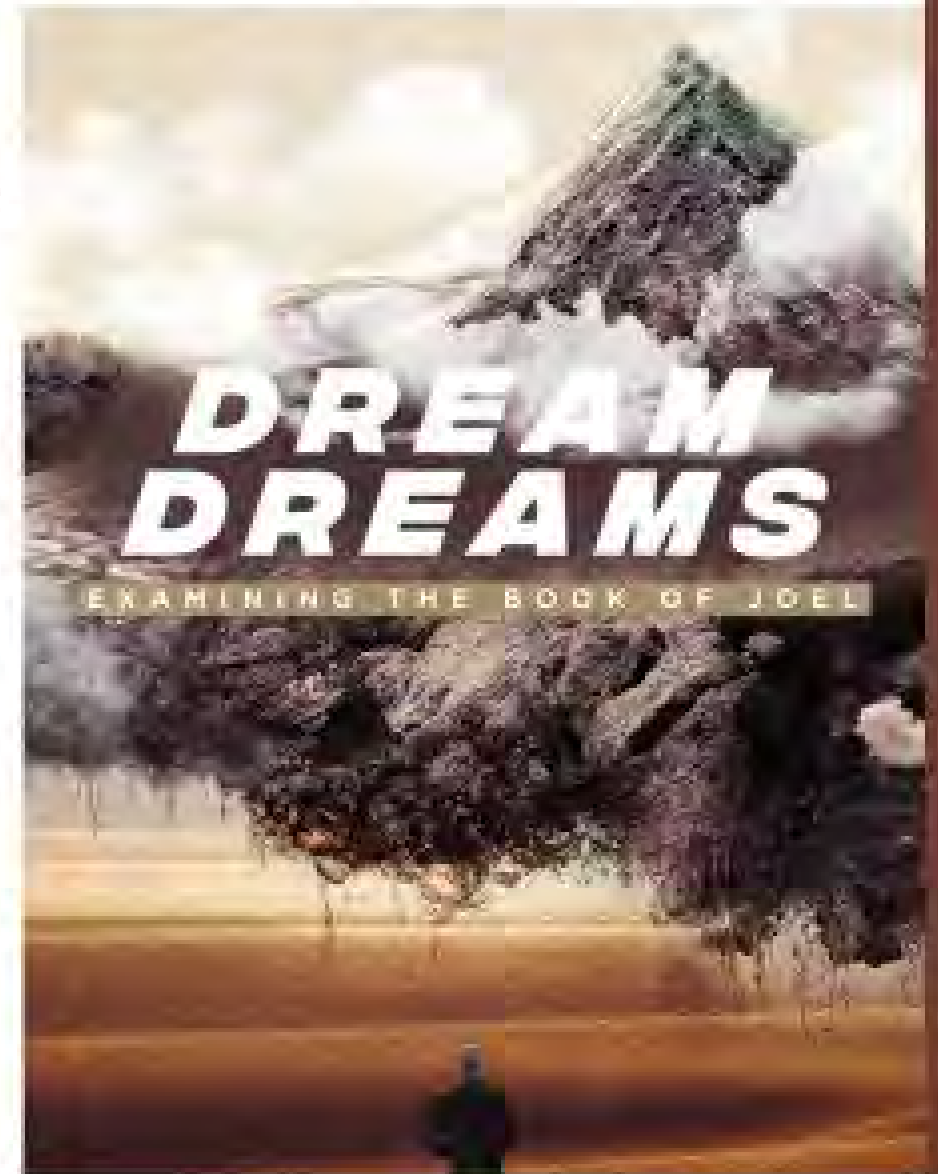


### **Joel 3:4 (TEV)**

<sup>4</sup> "What are you trying to do to me, Tyre, Sidon, and all of Philistia? Are you trying to pay me back for something? If you are, I will quickly pay you back!

### **Joel 3:4 (KJV)**

<sup>4</sup> Yea, and what have ye to do with me, O Tyre, and Zidon, and all the coasts of Palestine? will ye render me a recompence? and if ye recompense me, swiftly *and* speedily will I return your recompence upon your own head;

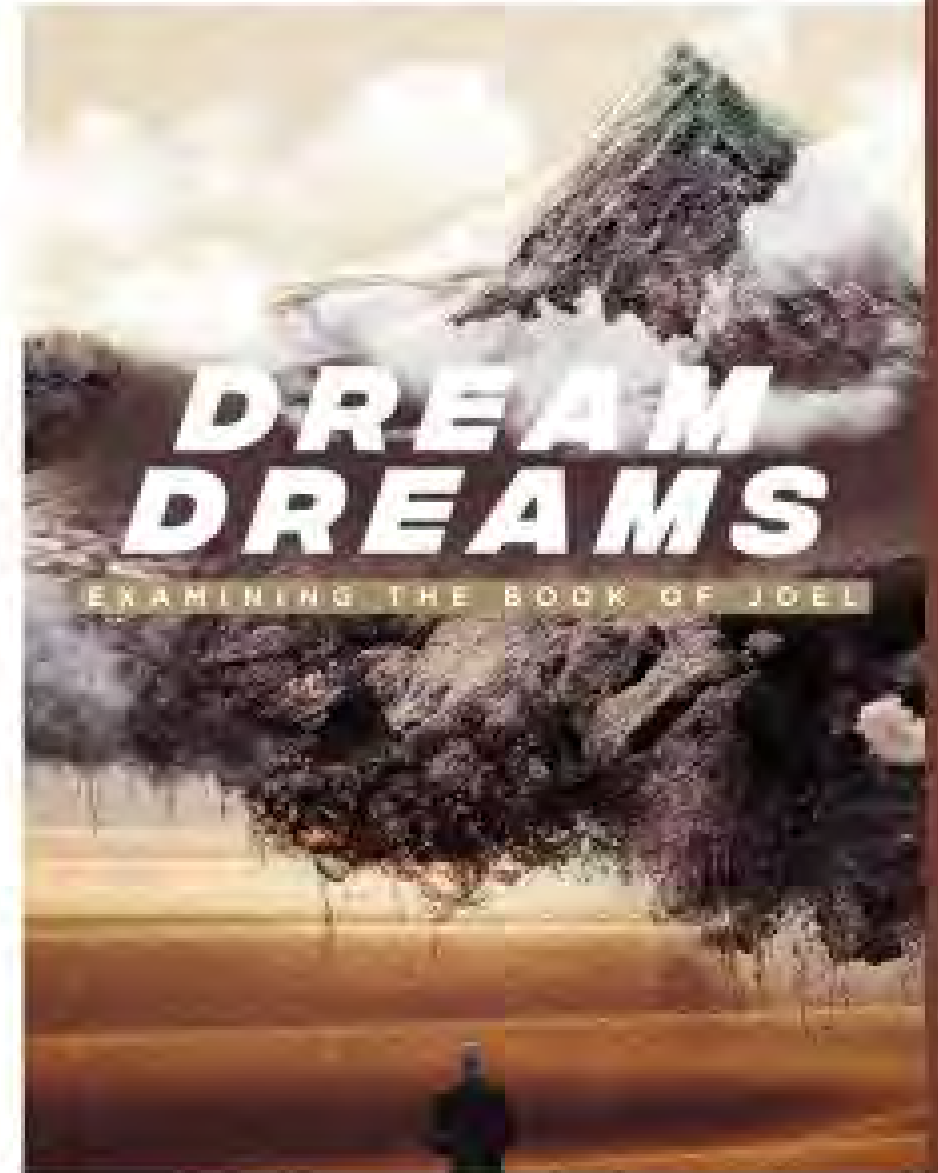


## **Joel 3:5 (TEV)**

<sup>5</sup> You have taken my silver and gold and carried my rich treasures into your temples.

## **Joel 3:5 (KJV)**

<sup>5</sup> Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

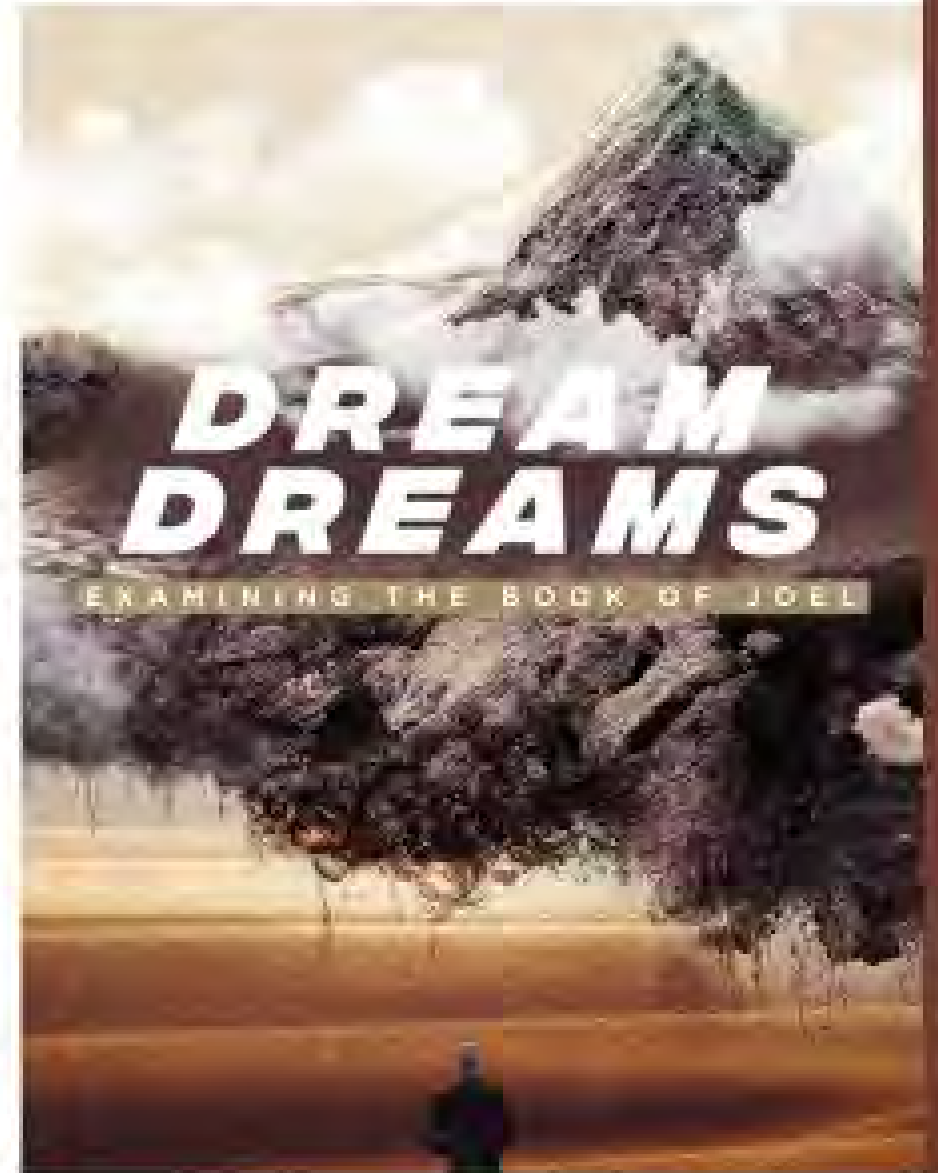


## **Joel 3:6 (TEV)**

<sup>6</sup> You have taken the people of Judah and Jerusalem far from their own country and sold them to the Greeks.

## **Joel 3:6 (KJV)**

<sup>6</sup> The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

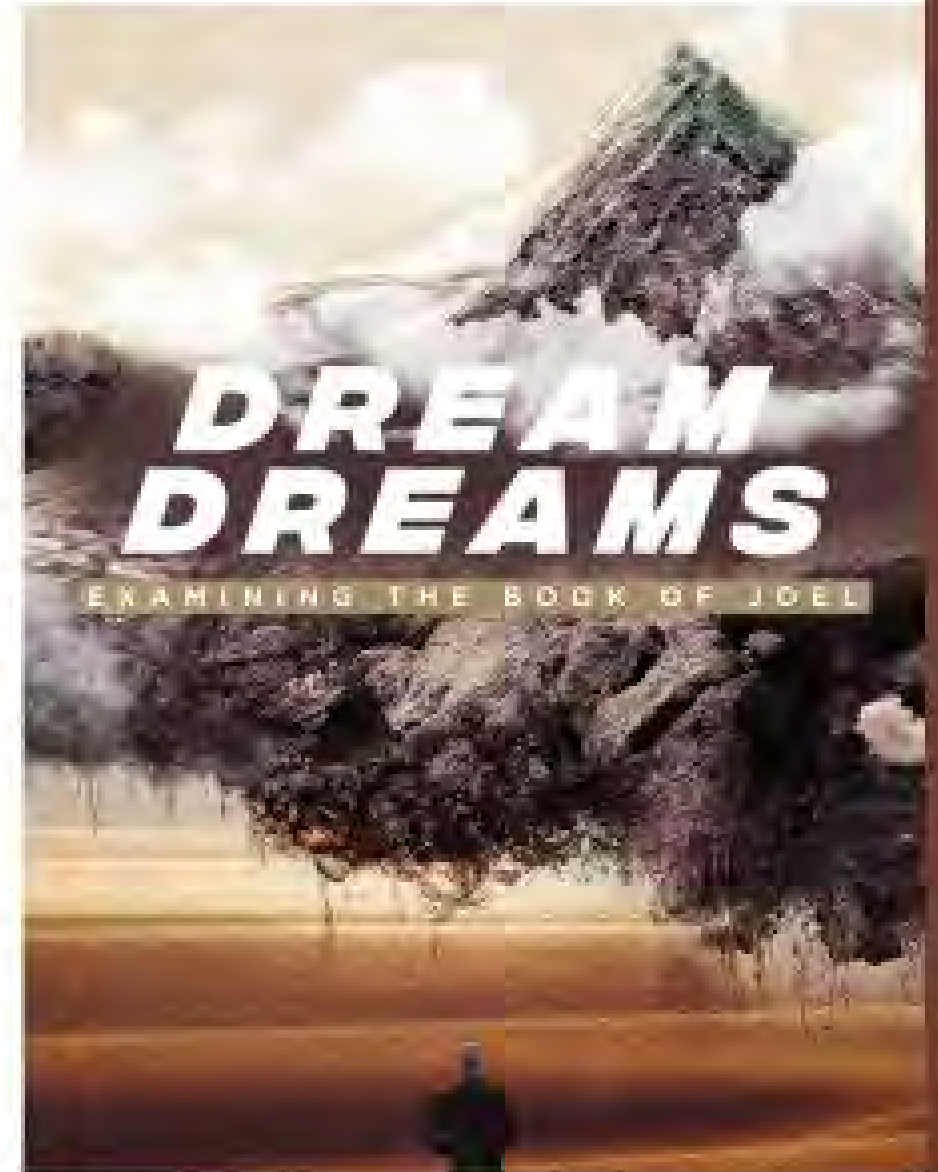


## **Joel 3:7 (TEV)**

<sup>7</sup> Now I am going to bring them out of the places to which you have sold them. I will do to you what you have done to them.

## **Joel 3:7 (KJV)**

<sup>7</sup> Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them, and will return your recompence upon your own head:

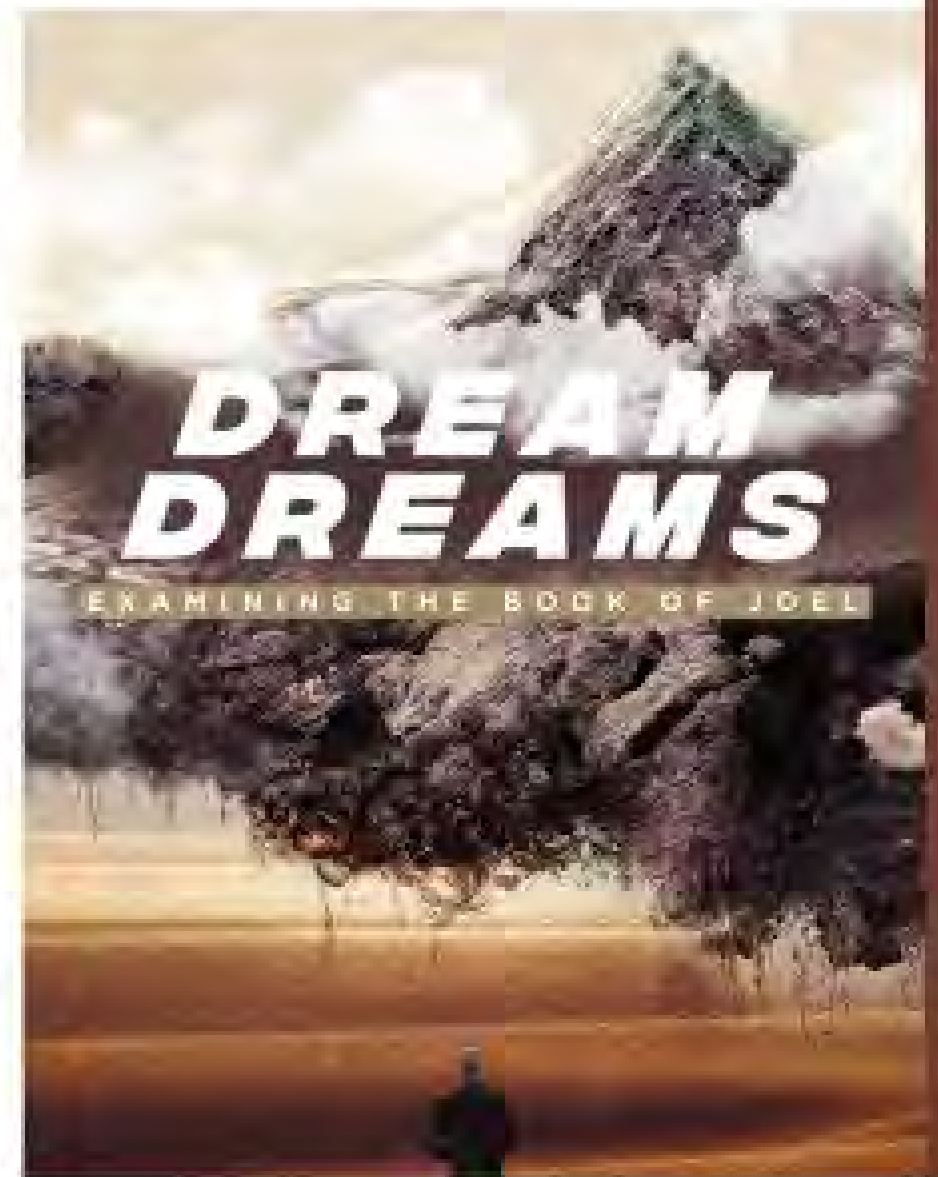


## **Joel 3:8 (TEV)**

<sup>8</sup> I will let your sons and daughters be sold to the people of Judah; they will sell them to the far-off Sabeans. I, the LORD, have spoken.

## **Joel 3:8 (KJV)**

<sup>8</sup> And I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the children of Judah, and they shall sell them to the Sabeans, to a people far off: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.

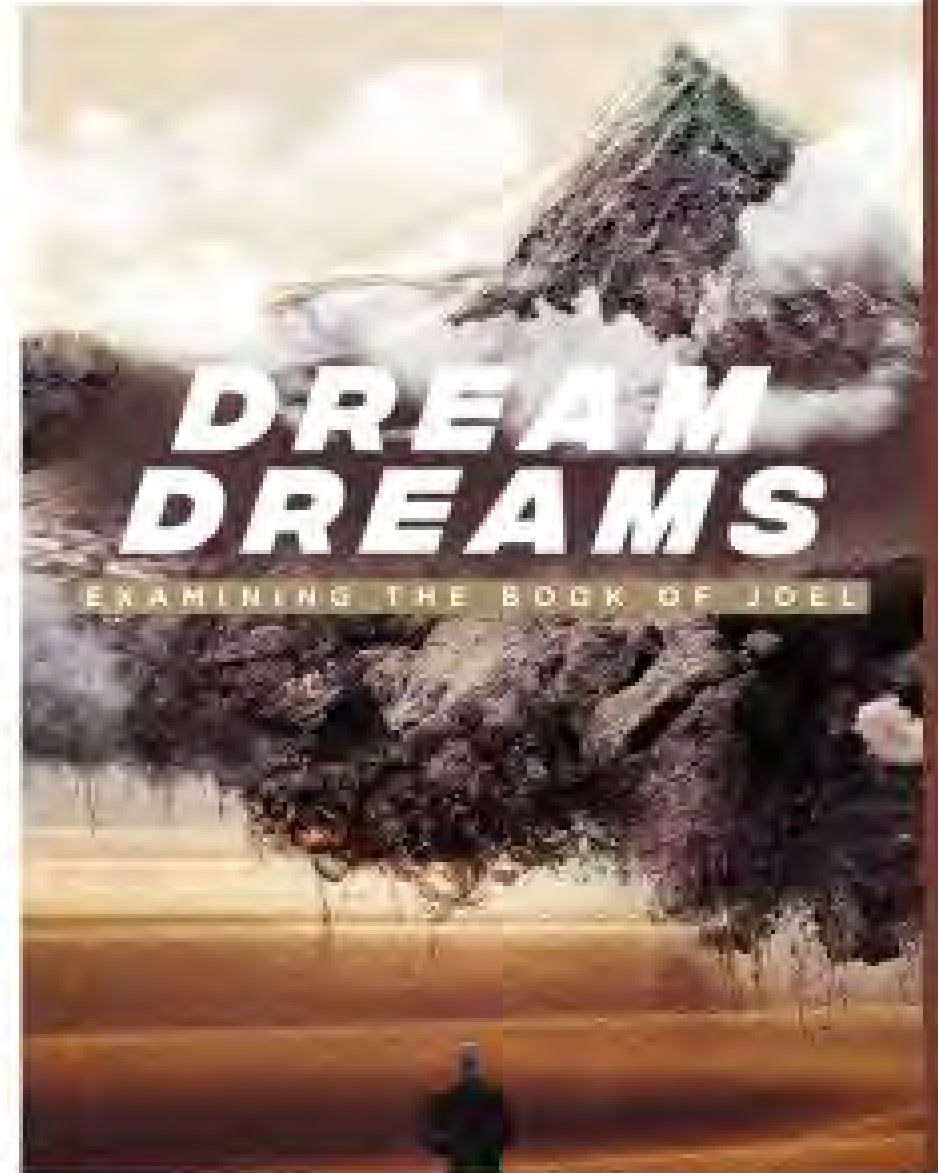


## **Joel 3:9 (TEV)**

<sup>9</sup> "Make this announcement among the nations: 'Prepare for war; call your warriors; gather all your soldiers and march!

## **Joel 3:9 (KJV)**

<sup>9</sup> Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:

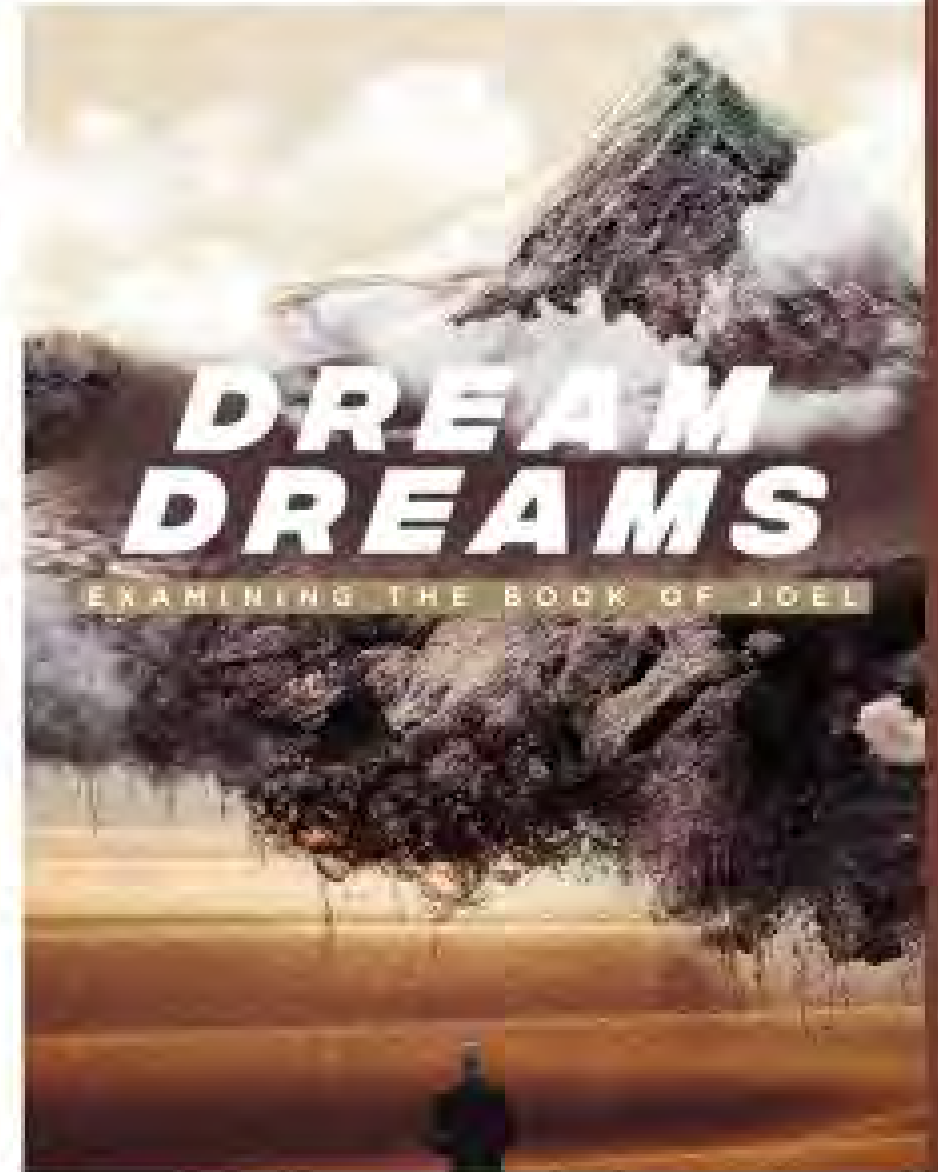


## **Joel 3:11 (TEV)**

<sup>11</sup> Hurry and come, all you surrounding nations, and gather in the valley.' " Send down, O LORD, your army to attack them!

## **Joel 3:11 (KJV)**

<sup>11</sup> Assemble yourselves, and come, all ye heathen, and gather yourselves together round about: thither cause thy mighty ones to come down, O LORD.





## **Joel 3:12 (TEV)**

<sup>12</sup> "The nations must get ready and come to the Valley of Judgment. There I, the LORD, will sit to judge all the surrounding nations.

## **Joel 3:12 (KJV)**

<sup>12</sup> Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.

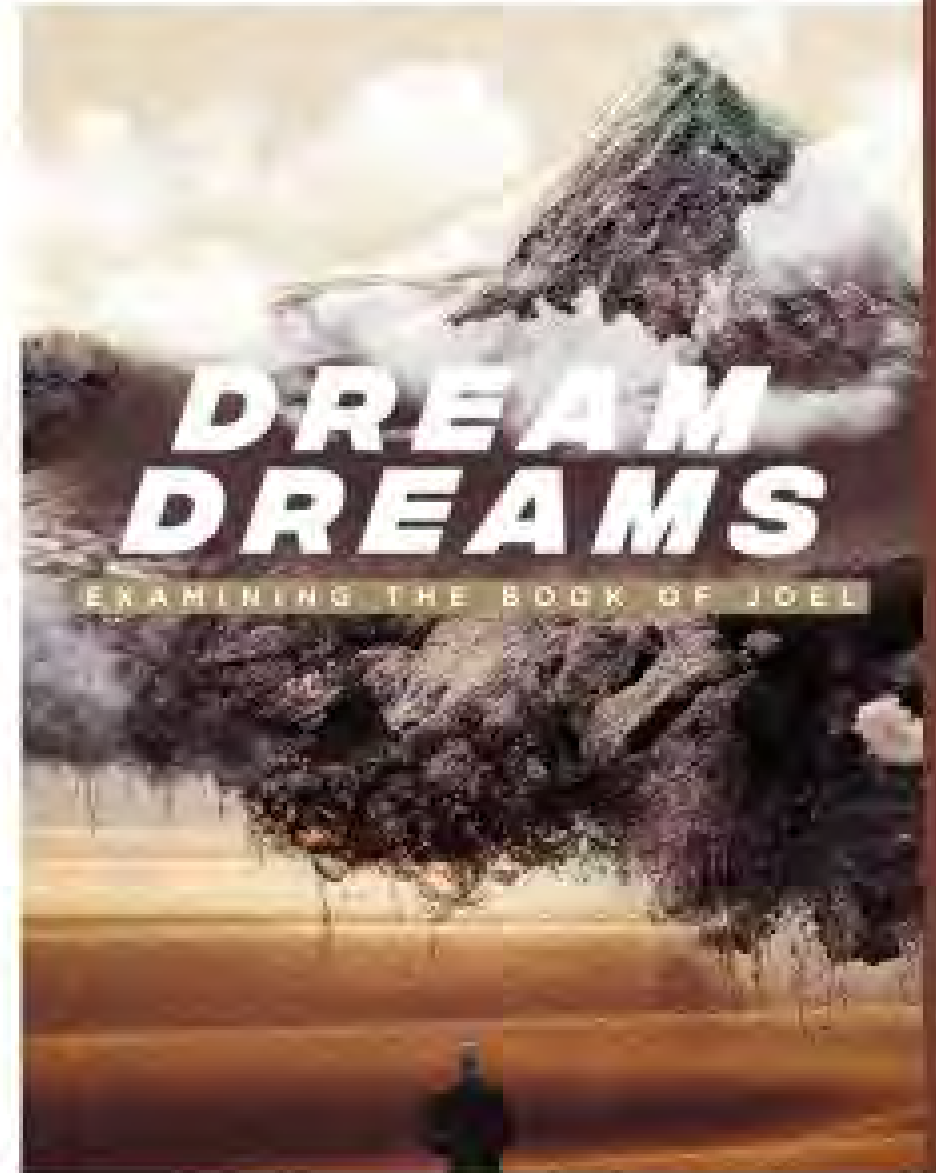


## Joel 3:13 (TEV)

<sup>13</sup> They are very wicked; cut them down like grain at harvest **time**; crush them as grapes are crushed in a full wine press until the wine runs over."

## Joel 3:13 (KJV)

<sup>13</sup> Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness *is* great.

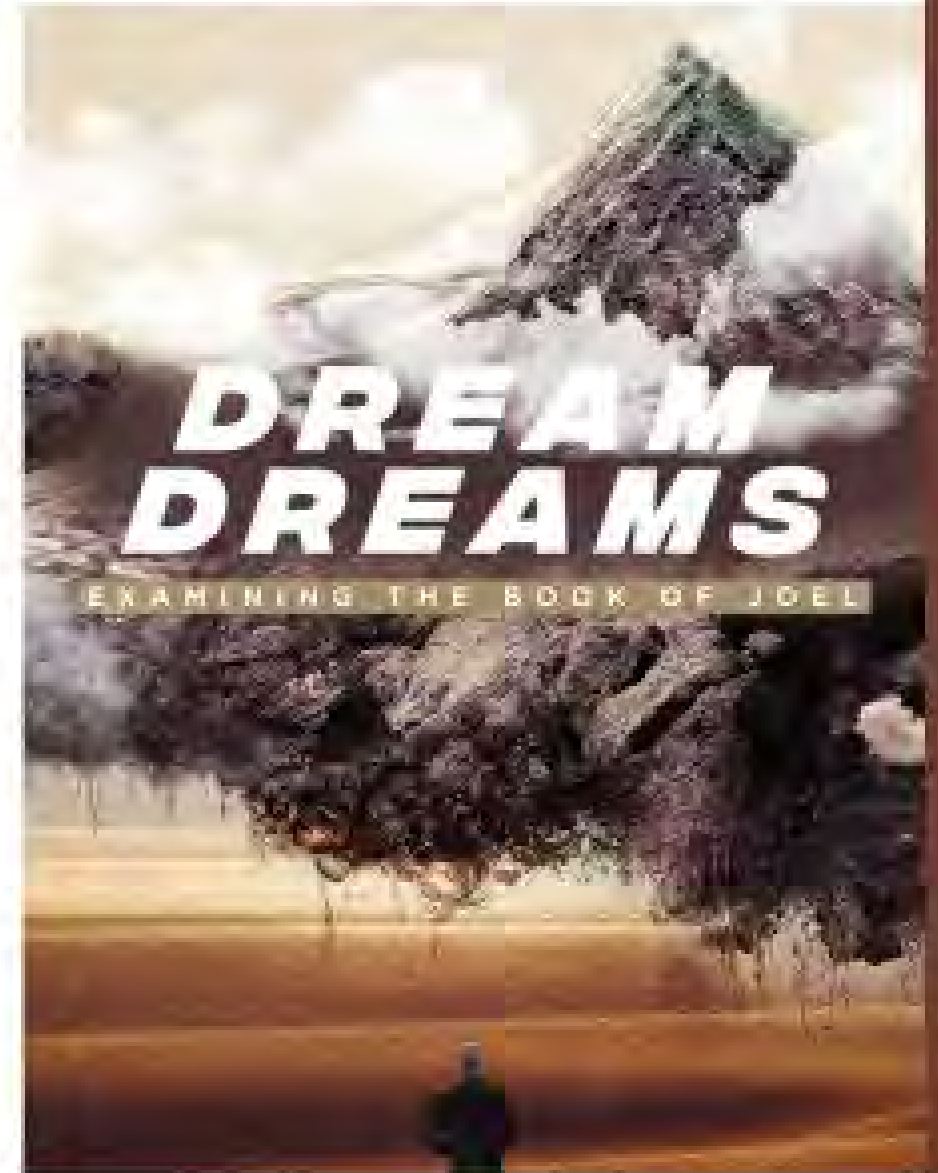


## **Joel 3:14 (TEV)**

<sup>14</sup> Thousands and thousands are in the Valley of Judgment. It is there that the day of the LORD will soon come.

## **Joel 3:14 (KJV)**

<sup>14</sup> Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD *is* near in the valley of decision.

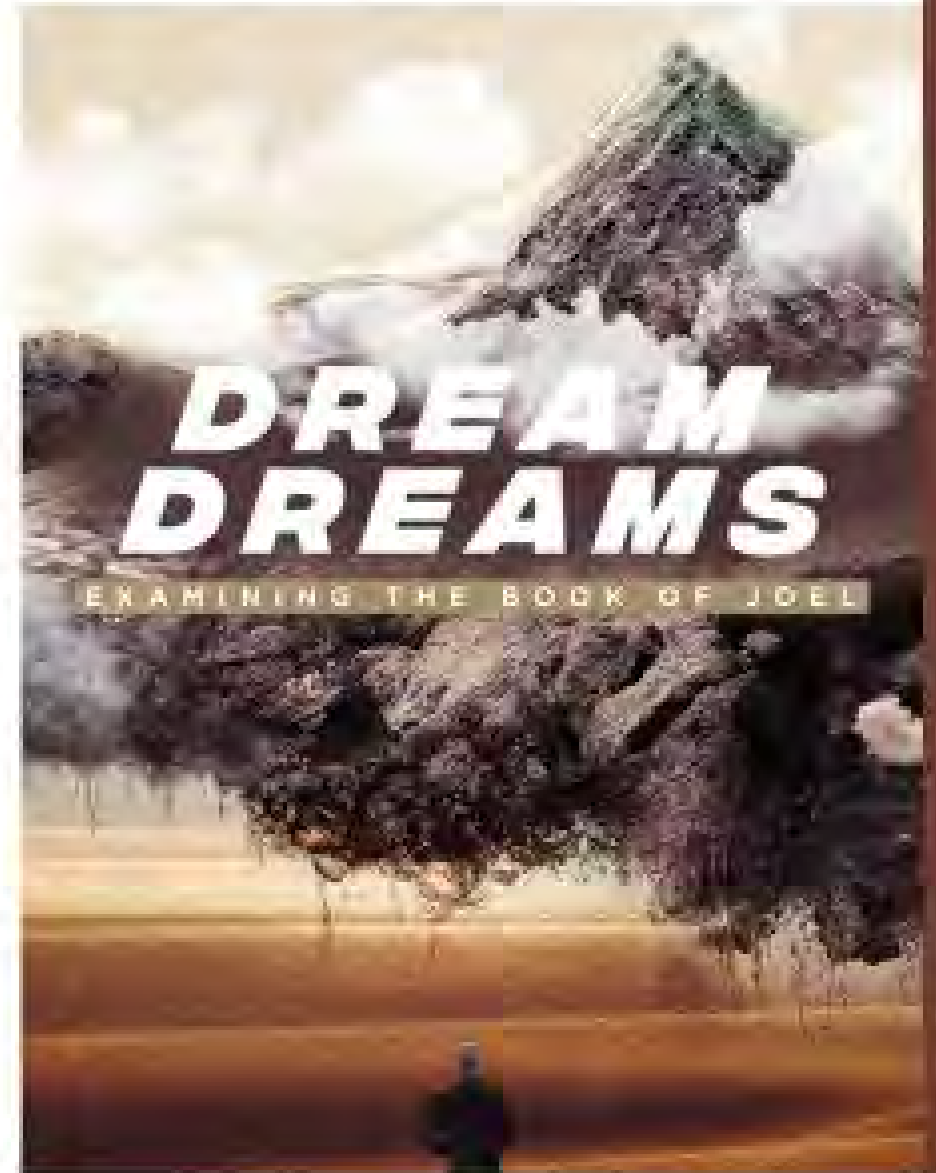


## **Joel 3:15 (TEV)**

<sup>15</sup> The sun and the moon grow dark, and the stars no longer shine.

## **Joel 3:15 (KJV)**

<sup>15</sup> The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining.

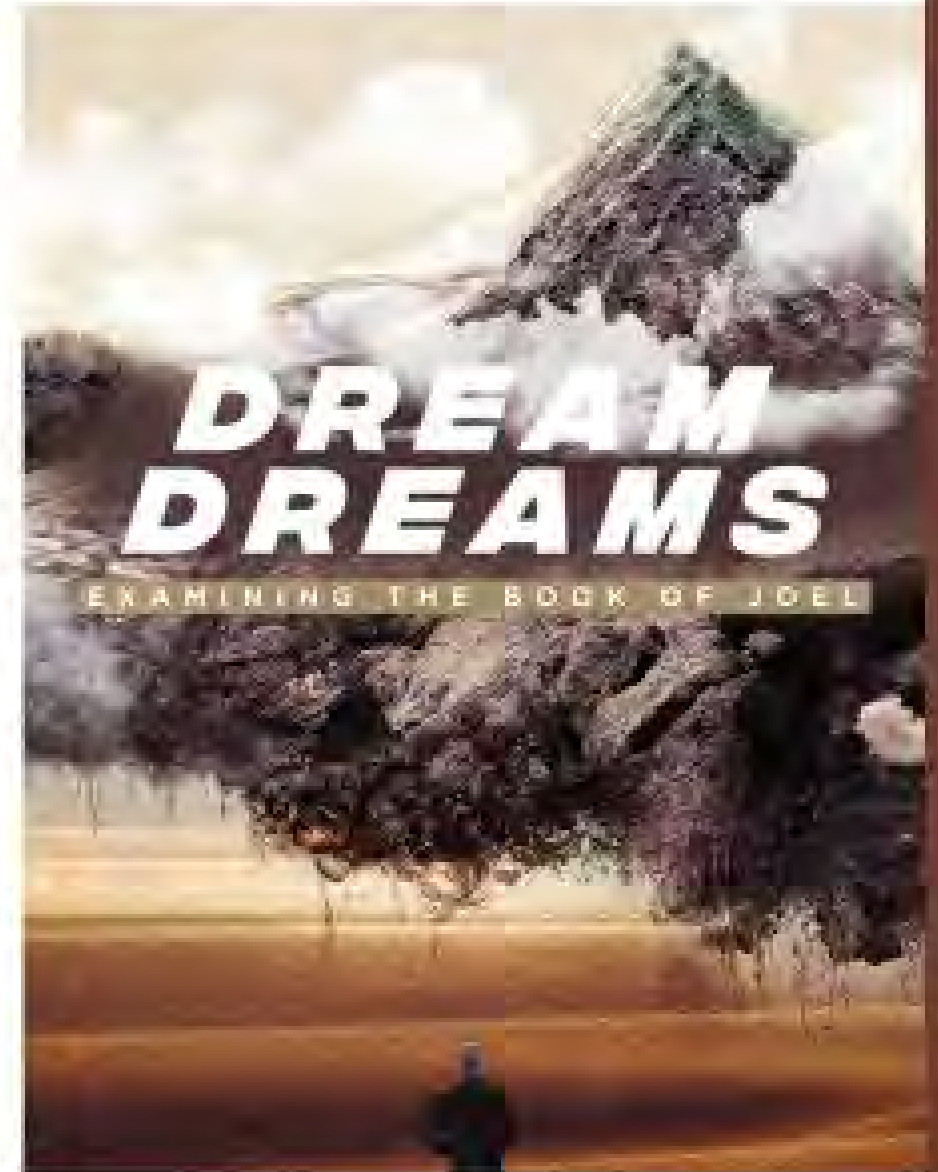


## **Joel 3:16 (TEV)**

<sup>16</sup> The LORD roars from Mount Zion; his voice thunders from Jerusalem; earth and sky tremble. But he will defend his people.

## **Joel 3:16 (KJV)**

<sup>16</sup> The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD *will be* the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

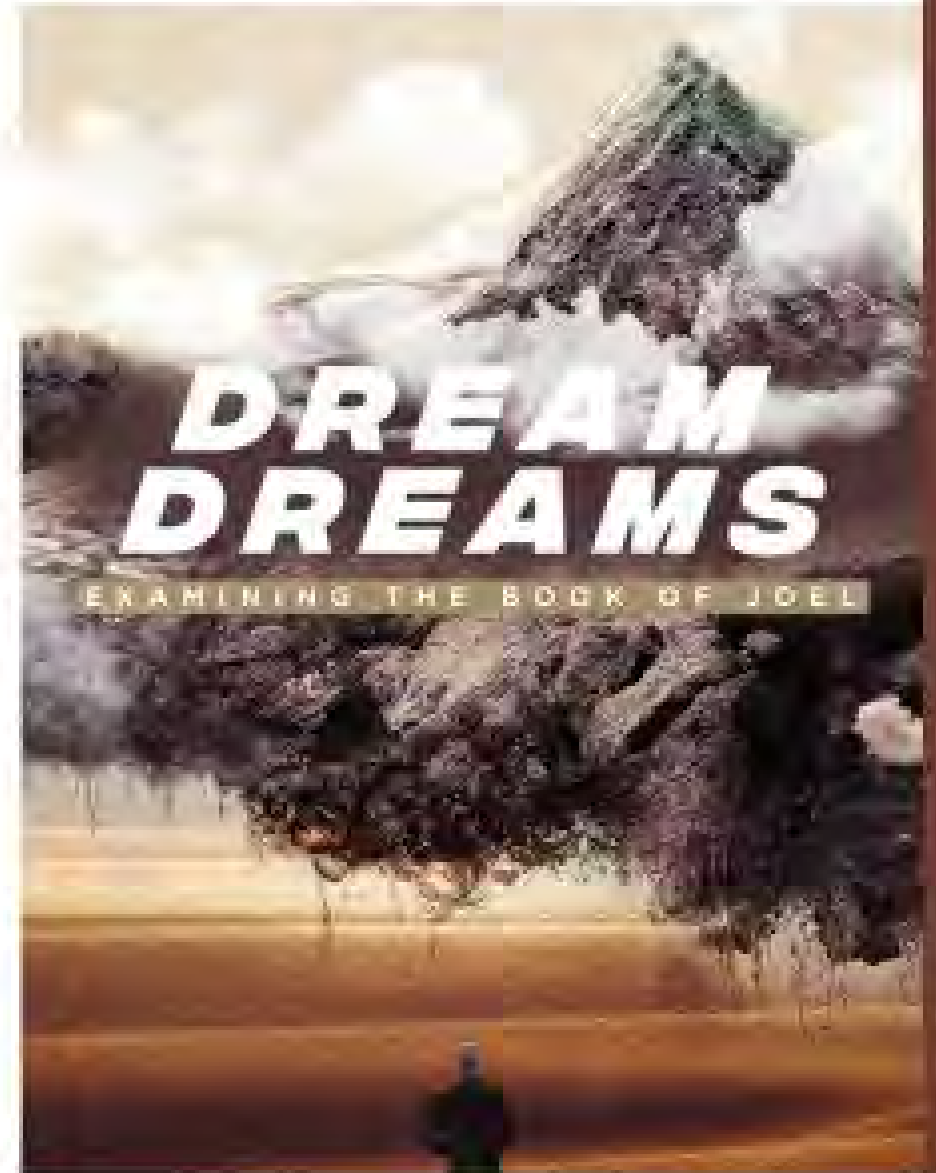


## **Joel 3:17 (TEV)**

<sup>17</sup> "Then, Israel, you will know that I am the LORD your God. I live on Zion, my sacred hill. Jerusalem will be a sacred city; foreigners will never conquer it again.

## **Joel 3:17 (KJV)**

<sup>17</sup> So shall ye know that I *am* the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her anymore.

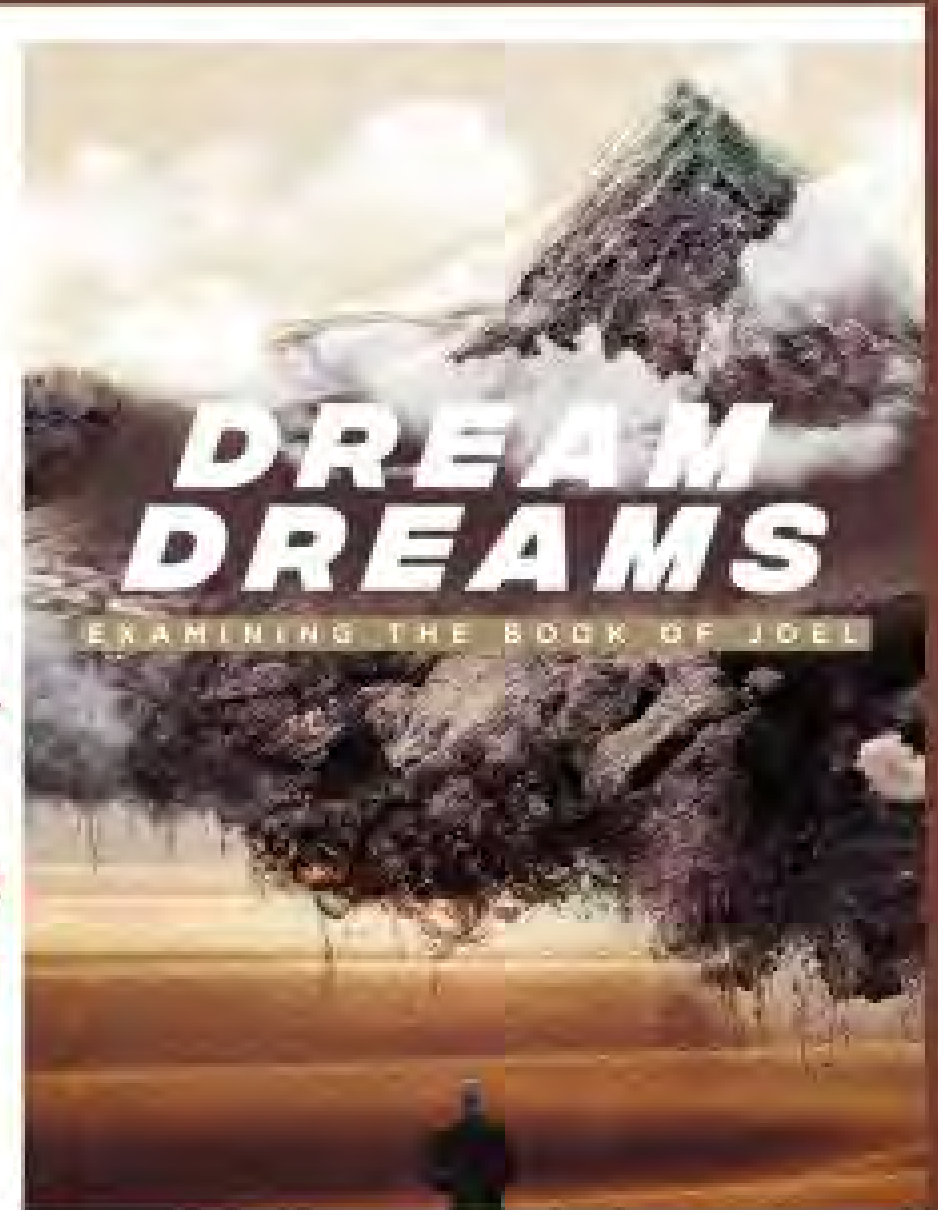


### **Joel 3:18 (TEV)**

<sup>18</sup> At that **time** the mountains will be covered with vineyards, and cattle will be found on every hill; there will be plenty of water for all of Judah. A stream will flow from the Temple of the LORD, and it will water Acacia Valley.

### **Joel 3:18 (KJV)**

<sup>18</sup> And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.



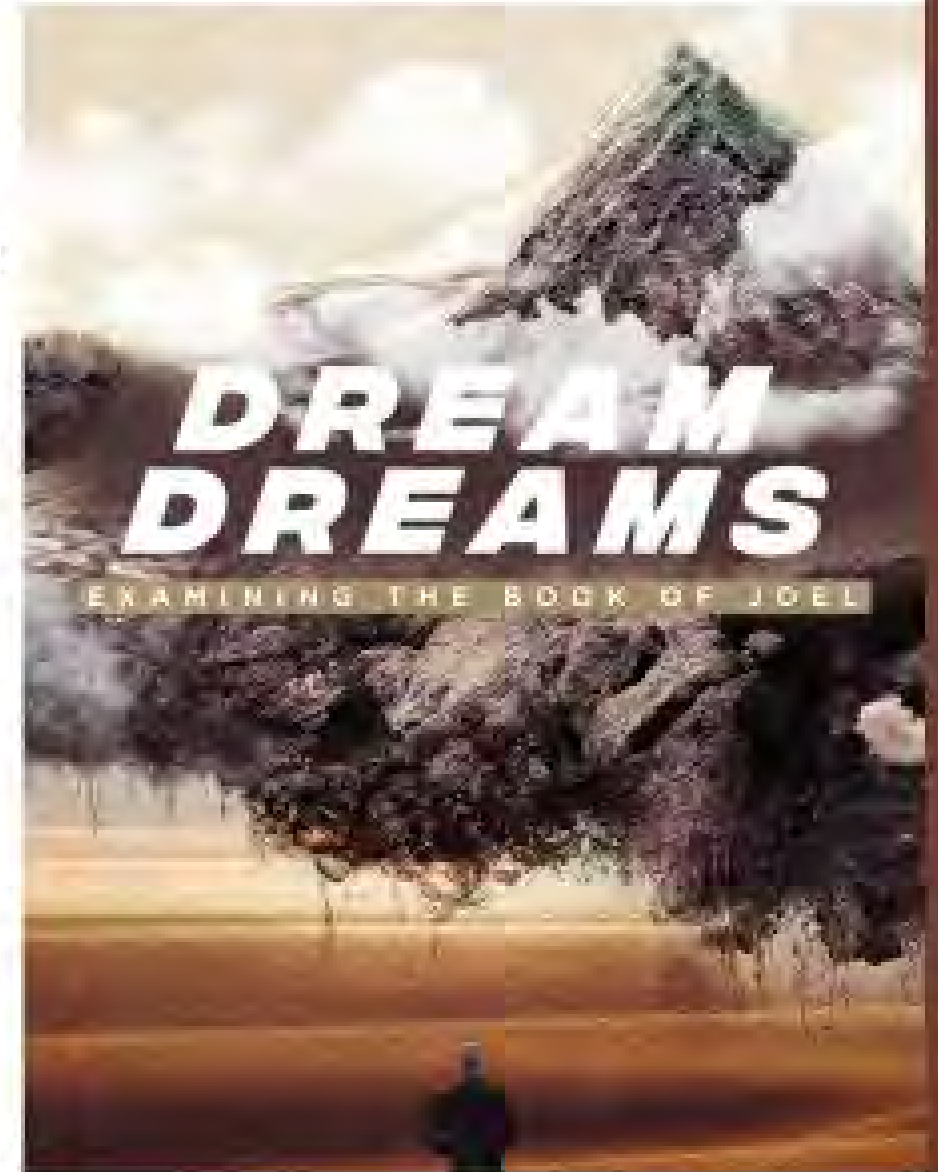


## **Joel 3:19 (TEV)**

<sup>19</sup> "Egypt will become a desert, and Edom a ruined waste, because they attacked the land of Judah and killed its innocent people.

## **Joel 3:19 (KJV)**

<sup>19</sup> Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence *against* the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

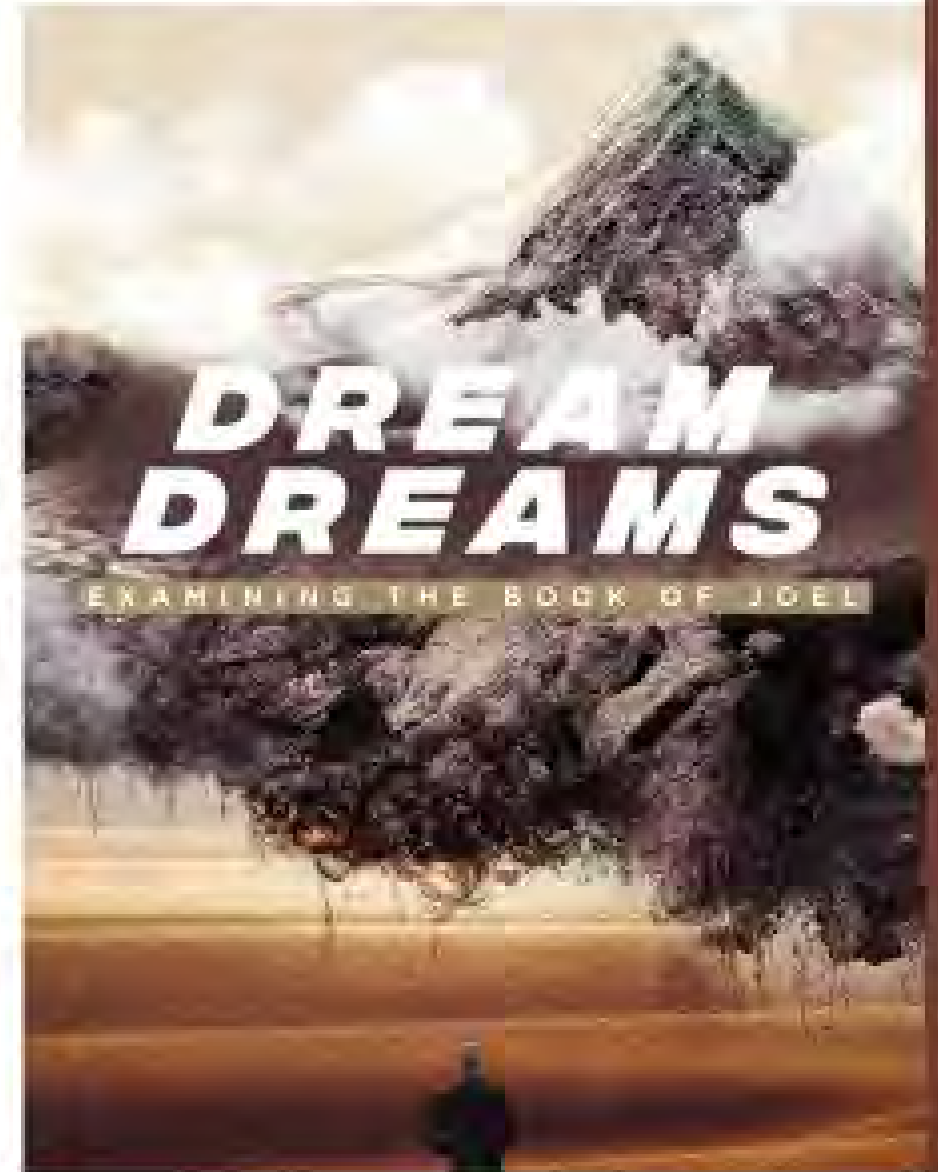


## **Joel 3:20 (TEV)**

<sup>20</sup> I will avenge those who were killed; I will not spare the guilty. But Judah and Jerusalem will be inhabited forever, and I, the LORD, will live on Mount Zion."

## **Joel 3:20 (KJV)**

<sup>20</sup> But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

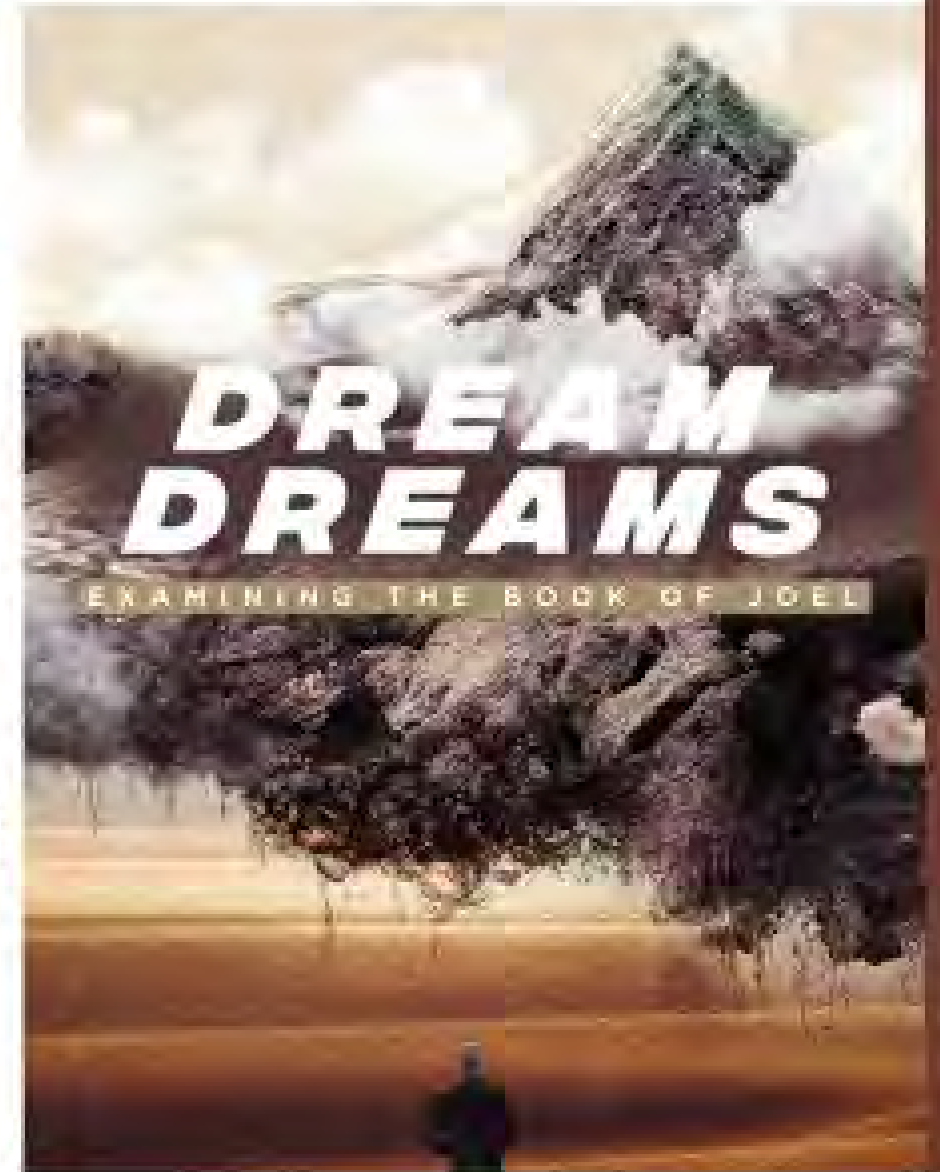


## **Joel 3:21 (KJV)**

<sup>21</sup> For I will cleanse their blood  
*that* I have not cleansed: for the  
LORD dwelleth in Zion.

## **Joel 3:21 (NIV)**

<sup>21</sup> Their bloodguilt, which I have  
not pardoned, I will pardon.' The  
LORD dwells in Zion!
