Why are relationships so important?

- Our relationship to God determines our <u>eternal destiny</u>.
 - There is no such thing as the Fatherhood of God and the brotherhood of all men.
 - John 1:12-13
 - 1John 3: 1
 - There is no such thing as an <u>alternate route</u> to the Father in Heaven.
 - Colossians 1:21-22
- Our fellowship with God is determined by **earthly relationships**
 - o Love is God's greatest command
 - Love is God's first command
 - Matthew 22:37-40
 - Love is God's <u>oldest</u> command
 - 1 John 3:11
 - Leviticus 19:18
 - o Love is God's **complete** command
 - Matt 22:40
 - Romans 13:9
- Our <u>sonship</u> in God's family is verified by our relationships with the people of our life.
 - o 1 John 4:7-8
