DANIEL CHAPTER 7

The beasts in Daniel 7 parallel the image in chapter 2.

The 4 beasts (in 7:1-4) represent the rulers of the four world empires previously described in Nebuchadnezzar's dream in chapter 2.

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream Chapter 2	Daniel's Vision Chapter 7	Interpretation
Head of Gold	Lion	Babylon
Chest and Arms of Silver	Bear	Medo-Persia
Belly and Thighs of Brass	Leopard	Greece
Legs of Iron	Beast with iron teeth	Rome
10 Toes of Iron/Clay	10 horns	End Time League of 10 Nations

Specific Interpretations:

"The fourth Beast" (v. 7) = Rome

The **"10 horns"** = a confederacy of <u>10 kings</u> (v. 24; cp. Rev. 17:12, 16; 19:19)

The "Little horn with the big mouth" (v. 8-11) = The future Anti-christ

--"Eyes...mouth" (v. 8) - identifies the "little horn" as a person, a human being.

--"Little" - speaks only of his <u>beginnings</u>; he starts off small, but through diplomacy he will during the first 3-1/2 years of the Tribulation exalt himself (with Satan's power) globally.

--"The thrones were cast down" (v. 9) - the Gentile thrones (kings and kingdoms) are destroyed ("cast down") (cp. 2:44)

--"The voice of great words" - Antichrist's blasphemy (v. 11) (Rev. 13:5, 6)

--"The Beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame" (v. 11) - Antichrist will be thrown alive into the Lake of Fire (Rev. 19:20; 20:10)

--"**The rest of the beasts**" (v. 12) - the previously mentioned 3 beasts (v. 4-6) had their kingdoms and power taken away successively; yet their worldly philosophies, systems, culture, and practices were <u>absorbed</u> (<u>assimilated</u>) by the kingdoms that took them over, and in this sense "their lives were prolonged."

Characteristics of the Antichrist

He will be:

- 1. A <u>fearsome leader</u> (v. 20). "More stout" = more imposing or fearsome. Antichrist will impress the godless world by his clout, power, personality, and boastful mouth.
- 2. A <u>cruel persecutor</u> (v. 21) He will war against the saints (Jew & Christian) during the <u>second half</u> the Tribulation (cp. v. 25; Rev. 13:7, 12:11-13)
- **3.** An <u>arrogant blasphemer</u> (v. 25 He will talk about God with contempt and set himself up as God) See Daniel 11:36
- A <u>powerful despot</u> (v. 25 He will attempt to change that which only God has the right to change).
 He will rule globally for 3-1/2 years.
- 5. A <u>military-obsessed</u> idolater (Dan. 11:37-38)
- 6. A <u>Satanic deceiver</u> (II Thes. 2:9; Rev. 13:3, 4)

7. A man of <u>lawlessness</u> (II Th. 2:3)
