ANSWER: THE RIGHTEOUS SHALL BE DELIVERED FROM DEATH ITSELF AT THE LAST DAY, AND EVEN IN DEATH ARE DELIVERED FROM THE STING AND CURSE OF IT;^A SO THAT, ALTHOUGH THEY DIE, YET IT IS OUT OF GOD'S LOVE,^B TO FREE THEM PERFECTLY FROM SIN AND MISERY,^C AND TO MAKE THEM CAPABLE OF FURTHER COMMUNION WITH CHRIST IN GLORY, WHICH THEY THEN ENTER UPON.^D
