Wisdom in Creation (Psalm 104:24; Jeremiah 10:11-12)

Wisdom in the Church (Ephesians 3:8-11)

Wisdom in the Gospel of Jesus
(Isaiah 11:1-2; Matthew 13:53-54; Colossians 2:2-3; 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; 2:6-8)
